What is A Blessing

The scripture says, "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above" (James 1:17). Anything God gives comes from the heavens, not from the earth. Many people have mistaken the things from above with the things of this earth, such as houses, cars, jobs, or any material thing, which are substances of the material world.

Neither of these things are given from God, simply because they can be obtained without him. Any one without the slightest knowledge of God can get a house or a car, and even a good job, which standard American society is built upon. Yet, the things received from God can only be received with the knowledge of what God can, and will give.

"Love not the world, neither the things of the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him" (1 John 2:15). The Lord makes sure that his children have the necessities of life and life is a blessing in itself because he gives us those necessities even when all others have lost theirs. 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Inside The Black Church

Inside the Black Church is a brief look at the moral foundations and structuring upon which the new Black church is built. In today's society, the rapid growth of immorality that besieges our families, our youth, and our social relations as a nation seems to have crept deeper into the sermons of our pastors and has bled into the ears and minds of those who seek salvation. The churches are more and more practicing secular traditions and trends in order to capture the attention of anyone who may be a potential, paying customer in their huge, new mega-churches.

It also peeks briefly at the influence the white churches and well renowned pastors and their traditions have on the teachings of the black preachers and pastors. This influence is very apparent to the naked eye yet has been justified as being seen by the spiritual eye, that these forms of worship and teachings are approved of God. The consequences of this secular emulation of the world by the church are seen in the behavior of today's so-called Christians. Even among the true worshipers of God, the gospel of Jesus Christ has been replaced with the deception of, "the love of money".

"And he brought me to the door of the court; and when I looked, behold a hole in the wall. Then said he unto me, Son of man, dig now in the wall: and when I had digged in the wall, behold a door. And he said unto me, go in, and behold the wicked abominations that they do here" Ezekiel 8:7-9

The passage in Ezekiel exposed the sins of the children of Israel brought upon them by the leaders. Deep within the crevices of the synagogues and temples of God's chosen people were being committed numerous acts of immorality and abominations. However, using the eyes of God, Ezekiel saw right through the outer appearance of the worshipers and straight to the sins.

In today's church world, there lies a thick layer of pretense over the creditableness of believers and the leaders. Only with the eye of God can anyone pierce through the wall and see the many abominations being committed by the church today. Not many will agree with these observations because many are blind to them, they can only see the surface of the church in its relationship to them. Even the leaders, pastors, and so-called Bishops of the many church organizations throughout the United States are blind to the ills they are inflicting upon the gullible minds of people who truly seek the knowledge and goodness of God. Therefore, the products of their teachings are also blind, which will eventually lead to millions of souls who are bound for eternal damnation.

It begins with the culture of the American society, which demands prosperity in a capitalist atmosphere. This means that anyone is free to pursue large amounts of wealth by free enterprise and will be justified by the Federal Government to use it to produce more wealth. It shows success and the accomplishment of the "American Dream", which gives a person status and a classification in society. Fame and fortune go together in this country and whether you are a corporate executive or an anointed preacher of the gospel, this is the mark of success. Well, the church has adapted this mentality and has taught it to the minds of millions of churchgoers.

It is a known fact that blacks have been striving to catch up with whites every since they have been freed from slavery. In order to arrive at the goal they have fought for civil rights, equal rights, social and economical rights (in which we still battle) and freedom from numerous forms of prejudice and discrimination. Along this road of struggle, blacks have measured success by the material things they own and the education they have acquired. In addition to the manner in which they speak, the fashion in which they dress, the status and positions in which they hold, and many other attributes and cultural traits of the white race. But in a hard fought effort to be recognized by, and equal to, white America, blacks have never stopped to find their own identity.

The Black Church is the only institution that can be considered the closest cultural identity to black Americans in the history of this country. However, the leaders of the Black churches pattern themselves after the fashion of the white ones. Some black preachers have degrees of religious education as a result of emulating white status: some Black preachers use the tactics of capitalist minded white preachers by converting their churches into money laundering houses of worship. Then there are the less fortunate black preachers who adopt the attitudes of the former Negro leaders - who fought for material and statistical recognition by intertwining the theory of material gain with the gospel of salvation in order to attain this recognition. Finally, there are the lower income black churches who still hold to the teachings and traditions that possess the slave mentality which is, faith in a better world, one without oppression and discrimination, but they too, are beginning to place great emphases on material gain and education.

Christianity can definitely be distinguished when it comes to culture. A country over seas may have an entirely different tradition of for instance, the family structure, than America would. Many countries place greater emphasis on children's' upbringing than does America, to the extreme of military schools that children attend immediately after high school, or even total abstinence until marriage. These are values that America has definitely slacked in, discipline, even in the churches. Africa, and many middle and eastern countries have a higher standard for teaching children, it is a more customary and conservative teaching, something America almost frowns on now days. Moreover, when either of those countries adapt Christianity as their religion, they strengthen the disciplines by using the bible's standards as an enforcer, so Third World Christian families would probably have stronger family units than the black American family. That is because the black church in America has conformed to America's secular, or politically correct methods of child rearing. This is due to the black church's attempt to model themselves after white Americans. If a black American family moved to Africa or another country, or just decided not to raise their children under American standards and traditions, they would definitely be stronger Christians, and probably more faithful.

If the black church and family did not place so much emphasis on material things and status quo positions of authority, they would be a stronger people. Nevertheless, this fantasy world was created by our earlier Negro leaders who sought out recognition and status among our white counterparts as a means to acquire equality for blacks. The Negro preachers such as Martin Luther King Jr., and the Reverend Jesse Jackson, were involved not only in the church, but also the freedom movement. They were so caught up in equality for blacks, that they did not stop to think they were creating a people who would only be considered, "off-white". All those who have capitalized on the freedom of the black American when it comes to education, wealth, success, and political power to free their minds and souls, and in order to secure their "place" among white society, have left off morals, righteousness, family values and simple faith in God.

Now there is, within the upper-class of black Americans, a new master, a new oppressor, a new capitalist minded force that the still, lower-class blacks are fighting against; the Black Massa. He has the education, the title and a little power, and now he closes doors on the feet of a wandering black face saying that "there is opportunity out there, I got mine, now you get yours." Sad to say, this mentality is within the church. The preachers have big names and big churches with administration offices and accounting departments; they carry cell-phones and are difficult to locate similar to a corporate lawyer or chief executive officer. They teach the congregation to strive for nothing less than that, and they justify these teachings saying that it is the will of God. The will of God is not to be rich and superior to the point that if another Christian does not capitalize on the opportunities that America has to offer, they are missing the blessings of God. They teach that God will send you to college and get you a large house (that he wants you to own property), and a good job. That his will is for you to drive a beautiful car and to dress in nothing short of the most expensive clothes, and all these things will he give you, if, you give him a tenth every month. This is nothing but a religious form of capitalism, nothing more, nothing less.

The Black church is also a pit of abominations for obtaining a status among the people. A political arena for title seeking, position loving black folks who would never obtain these status positions in the white world, so they boast of their positions as Bishop and Elder and Deacon and such titles. Their ego is hurting because they actually have no identity among the white social elite so they dictate over the heads of blacks that have not the knowledge of God's true will. They do not teach the righteousness and humbleness of the messages of Christ, instead they would rather use their positions to dictate your life; to get into your business and show you how to get to where they are, which is only a color away from white. They do not teach unity among the people, they teach individualism and personal prosperity. They do not teach giving to one another, they teach tithe to the church. They do not teach love for one another (not when it pertains to the giving of property) but they teach lending, sowing and reaping. All methods from which capitalism derived.

The Black church has become a fashion show for those who can prove that God is with them just by the things they possess. They do not realize that all material things can be gained by anyone who has a job. They do not realize this because the pastor tells them that this is God's will, that you be prosperous and obedient to his law of tithing. They place tithing at the highest point of obedience to God as anything else, over love, faith, and righteousness, any of the true fruits of the Spirit of God. They fail to even realize that material things do not come by faith. They come by having enough money in a bank account, or enough left on a credit card. They are beginning to teach that God wants a person to have good credit and that he frowns on bankruptcy, and unlearned black people who are just ignorant to the mysteries and parables of the gospel of Christ eat this stuff up. Only because it fulfills their material needs and secures them a means of survival, and preachers who teach these things know this. They have studied the white preacher on television. They have read his books on God and your finances, mixing principles of the bible with secular principles of financial wealth.

The black preachers build their churches like the white ones do, large and informal. Black preachers have informal churches because they lack the know how to relate to anyone individually, they only know how to capitalize in industrial type institutions. They have accounting skills and management skills; they have been to the bible seminary to learn religious capitalism. They have studied under their white superiors and role models. They set up church centers now, that offer all kinds of ministries and activities, just like community centers that are setup by government programs: programs that help the underprivileged and

the "at-risk". They are informally buried in red tape and paper work with the added touch so-called house visits from church officials, much like social work, to check on a family periodically. They setup day cares and learning centers (to be politically correct), in order for the single mother to work a steady job. Then, at the end of the month the preacher can gracefully remind her from the pulpit; "have you paid your tithes sister", after she has given them almost half of her check for their secularly setup day care center.

The Black church is no more than an extension of the white church and it's forerunner, the capitalist American society. The Black church does not know how to relate to their people in social terms, they do not even have the slightest notion how to start. They lack their own format of organizing the black community so they steal what they know from American government. They do not even realize that they hold the key to prosperity, unity, and social control over the black families and the black destiny right in their hands every Sunday morning. They cannot see that the Lord is not a supporter of individual prosperity but of community prosperity. He is not a supporter of material gain but of spiritual gain; he is not a supporter of a monthly percentage of your income but of a continual giving of your mind, body, and soul. He could care less about who makes how much on their job or what you wear to church or even if you come to church, but he is concerned about your peace of mind, sanctification of your body, and salvation of your soul.

The effect that these teachings have on the human soul is detrimental in the understanding of God's will and a future stability in the gospel. If you teach a child all the tactics of being successful in life but neglect to teach that child any type of discipline or morals, you have robbed that child of an overall life of happiness. If you teach a young man to get the best education that money can buy so that he can support his family, yet you neglect to teach him how to love that family, then you have defeated your purpose. He will eventually loose his wife and children to his love for his career. The same goes for the principles of the gospel in leading a flock. If you constantly teach them how to rise above poverty, and that God will get you there, then they will fail to see the true significance of God; they will miss the whole point to salvation. That is what the Black church has done in an attempt to rise to meet the American standard.

When the basic essence of the gospel is lost then a church will be filled with insensitive Christians, who lack love and all other fruits of the Spirit. Judgment (common sense) is one fruit that cannot afford to be lost in the Black church. If this characteristic is lost, then a person cannot look at someone and see if that person is hurting or not or whether or not they are in need. Their entire perspective of another is based wholly on assumption. The assumption that gain is godliness. The way they measure another person's success or sufferings in the gospel is according to their possessions. If something tragic happens to someone, then they assume that God is not with them or that the person has disobeyed God in some area. If a person has accumulated goods (material possessions) then they assume that God is with them and that they are obeying him. This is very bad judgment. The scripture says that the saints of God should have enough common sense, or endowed enough with the spirit of judgment, to judge the world.

In turn, when a Christian loses their judgment, then they lose the ability to relate to anyone's situation. When a person needs uplifting, they may assume they need correction; or when someone is driving through a stormy season they may assume the person is totally lost, without hope, and cast them off as cursed. There are even times when a Christian who lacks judgment mistakes a blessing from God as something from the devil. Because they are constantly looking for material goods as a reward of God, they completely overlook the simplest attempt at peace. There are other times when they cannot hear Gods voice, and in their attempt to obey God they obey a command from Satan.

"The love of money is the root of all evil: which while some covet after, they have erred from the faith," 1 Timothy 6:10.

The fruit of covetous leads to false doctrines, misinterpretations of the scripture, a misconception of God's true will, and a lack of love for a Christian's fellow brother. All these unfruitful acts of the gospel stem from the love of money; seeking fortune which brings glory; and glory, which is a form of recognition, is what the Black church searches for in order to compete with, and in the white world. However, there are more righteous ways of being heard and respected in this world of racism, and that is to have God on your side.

To overcome this spirit of inferiority and covetousness in the Black church, the first thing to be done is to pray and study the word. Stay in constant communication with the Lord, sanctifying the soul from all the evil temptations of this world. The devil has come to the Black church just as he came to Jesus to offer him the riches and glory of the world but Jesus resisted, knowing that the kingdom of God is richer and with more glory. We as a people of Christ have been trying to fight toe-to-toe with the arrogance of America's founding fathers, when all that is required of us as an oppressed people is patience and faith in God.

The leaders of the Black church must lead their flocks away from all manners of secular formalities devised by the American governmental system or any world government not formatted after the Kingdom of God. Such as programs set up to adopt dependents of the black race, or certain laws passed that appear to be in favor of the advancement of the race but are actually a smoke screen to soothe consciences and pacify egos, or a simple crumb from the tables of apathy for the purpose of temporal satisfaction. The leaders must instill within all Black Christians not only the strength to endure daily sufferings in order to perfect themselves, but the strength and understanding to turn from individual prosperity (in the form of capitalism) and learn to depend wholly on God and his plan for the church as a society within itself.

We are a holy nation. A nation that should be governed by the principles of the heavenly kingdom, not the worldly kingdom. In order to survive in this world God has enough providing ability to establish for the church a system such as the one in the book of Acts, 2:41-47, and 4:32-37. The saints then were full of the grace of God; the power of God was continually upon them. They prayed together everyday, not just for an hour on Tuesday night, but everyday. They sold all their material goods they had accumulated by working for the Roman government and combined it together to begin their own communal system. The scripture reads that they had all things common, meaning, their only concern and joy was Jesus and the powers of God. They did not care about whom had what and who lived where because they lived among each other. Everyone had exactly what he or she was in need of. If a family had three children and another had none, then the family with the children were given more food; that is only common sense, and no one was jealous of the other. That is because they walked in the spirit and not in the flesh.

Notice; this system of governing was not a capitalist system because it was not based on individual gain or survival of the fittest, but it was based on equality for all. There were no racial dilemmas about who was superior and who was not until the devil stepped in and claimed that the Jews should be in charge. So it must be realized that superiority among races comes from the devil, so why should a people of God ever be envious and emulative of a race whose influences come from the devil?

God's children are of all one color and he has no respect of persons. The Black church must recognize that the white man does not set the success standard. Nor is your expectancy as a person confirmed by what you own or what degrees you hold; but it is determined by the love in your heart and your faithfulness to God, not this country at all. The bible tells us that there are many false prophets and teachers in the church, especially in these last days. There are many false confessors of Christ who sit in the churches. Pastors must begin to weed them out by preaching to denounce worldly possessions, worldly status, and worldly values that effect our families. Once pastors begin to teach true gospel, many, many confessors of Christ will leave the church and return to the world, in whom they worship anyway. If they are sincere about their own salvation they will stay and suffer with the true brethren. Pastors must stop conforming to the world trends in hopes of converting people and must return to truth in order to save some. "Better is a little with righteousness than great revenues without right." Proverbs 16:8.

Pastors must deny the glory of the world themselves and renew their strength and spirit in the Lord. They are so caught up in attracting people to the mega-churches in order to compete with the white church down the block. So caught up in bringing tithes into the storehouse just so they can preach their messages of covetousness over the airways that they have forgotten about simple righteousness. There was a person who commented that; "church people are the meanest people he knew." What he said was partly, if not totally correct. Romans 3:10 reads: "As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one." This prophesy has come true as it pertains to the Black church simply because their heart is entrenched in possessions, appearances, and positions, and not in love.

Pray that Black Christians do not adapt the same mind set as the white ones had when they built this country. They built it in deceit, using the word of God as a hammer. They drilled into the slave's head that it was God's will that they serve them. They drilled into their head that they were to obey them and look to them for any reward or favor and acceptance. They catechized us into the psychology of supremacy and subservient, which in turn brought forth in the black mind and soul a complex that scared us deeply. In addition, in the process of this evil inflicted upon us, it conditioned and trained us, without our knowledge, to become as arrogant and competitive as they, as we grew in a society of capitalism.

However, the black mind by nature, does not function well in a competitive environment. In an attempt to defeat its competitor, it tends to lose all sense of objectiveness, thus destroying any chance of unity. This is what capitalism does. It tends to distort justice. Look at how political elections are fought. With scandal, and lies and deceit, these are all attributes of competition. In the black mind and soul there is too much passion. The black mind truly seeks peace. It searches for love that runs deep and will embrace it. It rejoices when good surrounds it, and it is strong when others are behind it. The black mind is just and fair, if it has not been corrupted, and it reaches out its hand when its heart has been touched.

Blacks, Homosexuality, and the Church

Growing up on the west side of Detroit in the 70s and 80s, there was one gay guy that we knew of and maybe one tom boy in a 5 mile radius, which contained 1 high school, 3 middle schools, and close to 10 elementary schools. Today, there is an epidemic of gay lifestyle reaching kids as young as 6 years old all across the nation. Something is wrong.

Nature reveals one common thing, while societal standards stress another, and regardless of what politics, courts, or activist groups pronounce on society concerning any trends outside of traditional lifestyles, Black America always seems to get caught in the crossfire and emerge wounded in the end.

Such is the case with divorce in the 70s, drug use in the 80s, HIV/AIDs in the 90s, and now homosexuality. Whichever way the wind blows the immoralities of society, Blacks are tossed in the breeze along with whites, and as a result of racial emulation, we fight, we protest, and demand various rights all to the detriment of our own being.

The Black church and the men (and women) who lead them, are currently caught up in defending the politically correct lifestyles of gays. Never mind that the very Bible they preach from condemns such lifestyle yet at the same time offer deliverance. The Church and Money

There is concern as to the methods the church uses to collect and spend money. Popular opinion is split on the enforcement of tithing and various fund-raising methods such as book, CD, and cassette tape selling by the church, in addition to conference admission, prayer line fees, and even indirect membership fees to some mega-churches. When these methods are questioned, many defend such practices as needed for the expense of church operation. But let us weigh the cost.

The equivalent to such operation is that of a family attempting to maintain a living. For instance, as a family grows, the operating expense for that household grows and the need for more income becomes priority.

If the family wants to live comfortably with all the modern conveniences and supply their basic needs, they would need not only bill money but also disposable income. Such is the church, however, there is a difference.

The church has a mission to adhere to just as important if not more important than the family's reason for being. The church is responsible for bringing people into the knowledge and presence of God, the Creator, while the family is responsible for living as respectful and productive citizens within their society. To do so, they have to gain the skill-set and knowledge needed through education and work experience.

The church also has a two-fold mission: to fulfill their mission from God and to maintain a physical abode; however, the church should not use their mission as a means of paying their bills, which is what many have resorted to doing.

The church can, however, operate a separate business aside from their Godly mission, but using God's word to pay the bills is wrong because the selling of His words - no matter how packaged - forcing funds, fees, tithes and offerings from hard working people is not a part of the mission.

The pastor must teach the members to trust God in all things, including all provisional aspects of the church. God promises to provide for the people, the church, and the pastor but today's cost of living and luxury lifestyles has captured desires of the pastors to the point they desire riches to compete more than having trust in God.

They want to build big and fast and instead of having churches that serve the immediate community, they want worldwide ministries that require billions of dollars in operational cost, while the surrounding communities suffer from poverty and despair.

If pastors had true faith in God, and taught the members love for God instead of love for money, they would see members giving more for the church upkeep. Forced-funding discourages people. If one loves, they support who they love and want the best for them. Simply believing in this concept is considered faith, but the church today does not have the patience to live by faith, instead, they are impulsive and live by the sight of the eyes, prestige of men, and trends of society.

A Church Divided

Society is divided into factions primarily based on culture and racial background because by nature people who share similarities will collectively associate. Color, class, and educational background are subcultures in the nation, which proves this theory of nature. Whether we want to acknowledge it or not, these same variables divide the churches in the nation also, with denominational beliefs as an added factor. Is this wrong as in sinful, or is it ok as a law of nature?

Some believers of God see this division as a problem that should not be, and others do not see anything wrong, but believe it to be natural. Though the Bible says that "there is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ" (Galatians 3:28),

meaning that color, class, or gender should not matter in Christianity, separation and division of congregational worship based on these subcultures in society remain.

The Bible should be used to break the barriers of ethnic segregation and classism in the minds of those who believe in God so that no one ever looks on another to decide their worth. However, because of the different cultures in the church today, it is obvious that practicing Christians do not understand the concept of the above scripture.

Researchers today who publish statistics of racial stratification in America, proudly proclaim the advancements of racial assimilation in the church; profiling individual churches who have ethnically diverse congregations. In their profiles, they try to figure out if this assimilation is good, or just the beginning of a resistance to integration.

Throughout America's history, we know that whites tend to move away from certain areas when blacks or other races begin to move in, and that they begin new schools, businesses, and entire counties so to remain the predominant majority. So, researchers seem stumped as to if this is what is happening in today's churches. Well, from a historical perspective, it is.

On the other hand, maybe God is fulfilling the scripture of Galatians by implementing social assimilation. However, this social assimilation has just begun and has a long way to go in this society and because it will take a while does not mean that God is not powerful enough to fulfill His Word, it means that society is simply resistant to His will.

The Word will work if practiced fervently, but it is not being practiced where social assimilation is concerned. People, by nature, feel more comfortable with their own kind. Is that an accurate concept, or a ridiculous one? Maybe the scripture refers to who can be saved in different races, classes, and gender, and that anyone can come to God no matter who they are, and maybe God knows that regardless of if they come and be saved or not, people will get saved among their own kind. After all, God created the different ethnic groups so He understands them.

Black Christians in America face two obstacles, prejudice and the tricks of the Devil, whereas whites face only one obstacle, which is the Devil. However, many people believe that race does not make a difference in Christianity, and this is true according to the scripture, but as proven by human nature, society resist the scripture and practice their own rules of social collectivism, which allows for segregation instead of assimilation.

Racism has become such a touchy issue and one that has taken so many turns as to its definition that many cannot see the truth. Reverse racism is now an issue, that is, blacks are racist if they do not like other cultures and choose to separate from them. If Blacks are racist based on their preference of whom they like and do not like, then why is it that when Blacks go to white communities, churches, or schools, whites leave and start new ones? Not to say that no Blacks are prejudice and that all whites are, but if the issue is blatantly disregarded, especially in Christianity, the issue will always go unsolved.

The truth is, there is a form of racism in the Christian mentality. Though separation of ethnic groups is a common practice, the will of God is not lived through the scripture by practicing Christians. For example, to this current age (the year 2007) publishers of Christian books and paintings continue to portray Jesus as a white man. This act symbolizes the mentality that the white sector of the church has; which is that race

matters. To portray Jesus, as any other ethnic background remains inconceivable to many whites, therefore, whites can never deny that it is they who promote racism and racist notions in Christianity.

Biblically, this is wrong and a sin because it is a form of partiality and hypocrisy. If a person cannot see this for what it really is then they are not rooted in reality, but in an illusion planted by Satan, who would rather not bring unity, but dissension in the church. The Christian thing to do is to unify, not deny. Do what the Word says, not what society practices. If ethnic assimilation is believed to be what the Bible promotes, then this is what we should do, but if ethnic assimilation is not believed to be the message of the Bible, then we will do what society enforces, which is ethnic segregation. Christianity requires love because God is love, but how can one who practices segregation because of color have love?

Defiling the Temple

Christians are quick to tell someone who drinks, smokes, or does drugs that they should not defile the temple; the temple being their bodies, because God does not dwell in no unclean thing. In fact, Christians use this theory in this respect only, not entirely understanding what they are saying, nor what the Bible really means by defiling the temple. True, the body is the temple, but the body of who, the individual person or the church body of Christ. Most would say both, but let's look at the scriptures and search for the truth.

Two scriptures address defiling the temple and we will interpret both. The first is in 1 Corinthians 3:16, 17, which reads, "Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple is holy, which temple ye are." At first glance, anyone could interpret this to mean the believer's body itself, and many preachers and Christians interpret it thus way. However, the scripture is speaking of the entire body of Christ and not an individual body. How does one know this?

The believer must always read the verses before and after the selected text to get full understanding of the concept because if taken in part, anyone could misinterpret the Bibles meaning. The actual meaning of the temple begins in verse nine which reads, "For we are laborers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building." The word "building" in verse nine refer to the church body or temple, as in all, and not one body, or individual. Then the scripture goes on in verse 10 to explain how every man should take heed how they build upon the foundation of God's building: the foundation being Jesus Christ (vv. 11). Verses 12-15 warn believers how they should build unto God's church and how their works will be tried by fire and if any man's work were destroyed, they will suffer lost.

Then, back to the original text of verse 16, which reveals that we are the temple of God, as in the church of believers together. Though each has his or her distinct ministry in God and they should build carefully, we are all building the temple of God. Therefore, if any one uses any substance to build the temple of

God that does not stand through the fire, or they attempt to bring something into the body of Christ that God would not approve of, they have defiled the temple; not the temple of their own body, but of the body of Christ.

The next scripture that address the body as the temple, to all intents and purposes, does refer to the individual body. Yet, again, Preachers and Christians misinterpret this scripture and apply it to more than what it actually refers. The scripture is in I Corinthians 6:19, 20, which reads, "What? Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's."

Indeed, the scripture distinctly says that the individual body of the believer is the temple of the Holy Ghost, but in what way does the previous scriptures refer to ways that a believer defiles the temple? First, the fifth and sixth chapter of 1 Corinthians discusses the behavior of the saints in the church of Corinth. The beginning of chapter five talks about fornication and how a church member laid with his father's wife. Then it talks about all who commit sins of the flesh, such as covetousness, extortion, idolatry, drunkenness, and more, and warns believers not to keep company with such people.

Then chapter six talks about taking your brother to court and believers exercising the spirit of judgment, God deemed it a sin to have bad judgment of menial matters in the church. Then in verse 12 the scripture says that "All things are lawful unto me, but all things are not expedient," meaning, a person can do whatever they want but everything they want may destroy them and capture them in sin. Then God compares someone who has been captured by some evil force to that of a harlot, implying that they have committed spiritual fornication.

Finally, verse 18 says, "Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body." Pay close attention to what the scripture says. It says that every sin that a man does is done without the body, except fornication, which is done with the body. All other sins are committed with the mind. If a person commits idolatry, drunkenness, covetousness, adultery, backbiting, spitefulness, or any other type sin, they commit it using the mind; even anger is deemed equal to murder. But the only sin that a man can do with the body is fornication. To further prove this, Jesus says in St. Mark 7:18-23,

"And he sayeth unto them, Are ye so without understanding also? Do ye not perceive; that whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, it cannot defile him; Because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, purging all meats? [meats for the belly and the belly for meats].

And he said, That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man. For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, [which when conceived in the flesh defiles the body] murders, Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: All these evil things come from within, and defile the man."

Therefore, sin and evil originates from the heart and mind. Nothing from the outside is considered sinful, such as alcohol, tobacco, or even cocaine, and even if these things enter into a person, they do not defile the temple because what defiles the temple, as the scripture says, comes from within a person. As radical

as this interpretation may seem, it is biblically justifiable and supported by reason. The only reason people believe otherwise, is because this is what preachers have taught without regard to what the scriptures actually says. Thus, spiritual discretion and judgment is needed to correctly apply this concept but remember, bad judgment is a sin.

Fried Chicken, Cadillac's, and Lipstick

At the turn of the century throughout to the nineteen thirties and 40's, Afro-Americans relocated from southern plantations to urban ghetto's of northern cities. There they found a temporal paradise in which many strove to success through education, factory jobs, organized community and church affiliations.Set completely free from the bonds that gripped and restrained them to the controlled activities overseen by their white taskmasters, blacks were released to pursue almost whatever they wanted, within reason. Black leaders rose up to speak for the masses: politically, economically, and religiously, in the face of much opposition.Many benefited from the fight for social freedom although many fell to the traps set for the newly emancipated Negro. Drugs, alcohol, and prostitution plagued many black neighborhoods as a deterrence to the fight for success and to overcome oppression. If the political representatives could not reach the masses, or if the militant movements did nothing for their dignity, church leaders shouted the words of the bible into the faces of drug pushers, dealers, and attics in hopes of freeing them from ghetto hell.

One most famous phrase shouted by hell-fire and damnation preachers of the 30's and 40's was, "drinking, smoking, and cussing." Nearly every sermon began or ended in this phrase. It became so popular that anyone found with a bottle, butt, or cuss word coming in or going out of their mouth in the sight of a preacher or even a church member, automatically felt the guilt and condemnation of hell beneath their feet. Unto this day, the phrase still sends chills through the souls of many people when coming from the mouth of any preacher. Though this tactic delivered many from the bonds of ghetto destruction, there are other sins of the flesh and spirit being committed by Christians that were not, and are still not being addressed by church leaders. Fried Chicken, Cadillac's, and Lipstick are a few that will be discussed from here on.

How can fried chicken be a sin? The chicken itself is not the sin but the way it is prepared and the effects of its consumption by millions of people. Greasy foods are the topic. They cause heart failure and high blood pressure that leads to all sorts of sicknesses and high doctor bills much like cigarettes do. Other high risk, greasy foods like pizza, bacon, salty foods, fat/lard-cooked foods, and especially fast foods, that are soaked and cooked in grease and who knows what else. The southern diet consumed by "Afro-Americans" such as ham-hocks, collard greens cooked in pork, all fried foods, and high amounts of

butter, which leads to outrageous levels of cholesterol, all contribute to sicknesses and diseases that "defiles" the temple of God.

Defiling the temple is the scripture preachers and many Christians use to warn against the use of alcohol, cigarettes and other substances. Yet, they never address the fatty and greasy foods they consume each day that does the same to destroy the body. Hypocrites you might say, or maybe just a tradition brought from the ghetto. Preachers talk constantly about how God wants his people to be prosperous by using the scripture from 3 John 2 which reads: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in good health, even as thy soul prospereth." They quote the prosperous part but never cease to neglect the good health part. That is because many preachers care not about the health of the saints but only about being prosperous. This leads us to the Cadillac aspect of this article.

Material things are dangerous if one's heart is set on them and not the godly things of the bible. Covetousness is the sin being committed here. Many preachers are stereotyped into the role of driving big cars and having nice things as an example to the congregation. The biggest myth being spread by church people is that "the congregation wants their leaders to be prosperous". That is only a myth and has nothing to do with the word or will of God. It is lived up to in the black (and white) community to the tee. It is a shame that church people, and their leaders, cannot live according to the humbleness of the word of God but live up to the standards and myths of the world. Prosperity is a portion of God's will but not to the point of covetousness. Preachers teach that God wants his people to own property. How is that justifiable when the people were selling their property in the book of Acts? How can that be justified?

Drinking is not necessarily a sin. The apostle's suggested wine as a healer in the New Testament and it was always traditional to have wine during supper and feast in those days. Nevertheless, because there was lots of drinking and boozing in the 20's 30's, and 40's due to prohibition and the depression, preachers have related drinking to sin and damnation. This is not reasonable thinking to a man of God. Wine can be used in modesty but not drunkenness. Yet, if a Christian is seen coming out of a liquor store, they will surly hear the situation from the pulpit the next Sunday. Cocaine is a dangerous thing, and a substance that will kill the soul and the body and should be condemned, even strong drink need not be consumed by even the average person, but there are things that are not considered illegal in the world that is just as destructive to the flesh, and preachers need to address these behaviors.

Lipstick promotes vanity. Where are the warnings against vanity? Even though alcohol, fatty foods, and tobacco is addictive and causes harm to the body, vanity cause harm to the soul. Yet, it is practiced commonly among women and men. Make-up, hairstyles, earrings and jewelry are all considered vain and meaningless to the advancement of the gospel of Christ. Nevertheless, in today's churches, every Sunday is a fashion show. The scent of perfume and cologne can be sniffed throughout any church congregation. Lipstick, hair spray, bobs, weaves, relaxers, fades, cuts, trims, tattoos, and many other vain displays of self-centeredness is just as destructive to a Christian as drinking, smoking, and cussing. Yet, preachers do not approach these issues. They do not address them because they partake in them.

As a defender of the people of God against all false preachers, teachers, and prophets, I, brother C.R. Hamilton, want to add these to the sin-list. Fried Chicken, Cadillac's, and Lipstick. Since many Christians and leaders are shouting how the times have changed and that us traditional folks need to come into the new millennium, preachers need to realize there are many other forms of sin being committed by them and their followers, that should be preached from their pulpits.

God and Country: Serving Two Masters

The historical American slogan "God and Country" is an example of a double standard if there ever was one, especially in the context of American religious and political ideology. Understandably, countries like Israel, India, or China can claim this type slogan because they base their religious and political ideologies on the acknowledgment of an ancient Supreme Being; but America, in its current Christian religious and Capitalists political system cannot.

In the context of the slogan "God and Country", the very Bible confessors claim to follow, says that a believer of the Christian Messiah (Jesus Christ) must choose either Christ or the country they live. "No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon" (St. Matthew 6:24).

The scripture means that in the case of any two opposing forces, such as God and any other entity contrary to His purpose, the believer must choose one or the other because they cannot serve both equally. Therefore, when people confess to and believe in the slogan "God and Country", deep within their subconscious, they either love God or hate the country, (hate as in cannot love) or vise-versa, or they are holding to one simply for the sake of declaration and duty and subconsciously tolerating the other. If one asserts that neither analysis describes their belief, then they have not full comprehension of the scripture's meaning or God's purpose. This mentality of either or is not discretionary but by the natural laws of human will, inevitable.

Israel, whom God promised to make of a great nation under the covenant of the Old Testament with laws and ordinances justified their existence, gave them a purpose, and fulfilled His promise by establishing them a land flowing with milk and honey. China, who serves Buddha, lives under the precepts and direction of their god and according to how they believe Buddha desires a society to operate. Any nationality of people on this earth who has occupied a territory from the beginning of time, no matter what god they believe, live and operate their society based on the desires of that god.

Any nationality that has adopted a religion and formed a nation based on that religion is not legitimate under natural law because they must make the nation work according to the religious belief. One such country is the United Sates; Christ never promised any people of his a country here on earth, in fact he said that all who believe in him would be pilgrims and wanderers throughout the earth having no certain dwelling place. In other words, Christians have no claim to any land or country here on earth, not according to the Messiah.

The founders of the United States built upon the grounds of America a nation using Christianity as a foundation, after they escaped the tyranny of Britain. They adopted Christianity, came to America and called themselves pilgrims, Puritans and Christians, and lived life according to the Holy Bible. Though

they were possibly much more dedicated to God and their purpose than today's average American is, the early settlers were in no way as tolerable or compassionate as we are today.

In a state of building a society - which must have been morally and emotionally strenuous - they practiced slave labor; corrupt business ethics (as in thievery against the Indians), and waged war with any one who opposed their efforts, all in the name of Christianity.

As proud and successful in their efforts they were to have founded and built a nation away from the tyranny of the Mother country, American settlers confused the purpose of the very Bible they studied with the principles and political theories of building a nation. Thus by conjoining the two concepts, using God as a springboard for Country, the founders formed Christian Capitalism. More ironic though, there is a striking contradiction between the latter two.

While Christianity is based on equality for all, capitalism is based on survival of the fittest and social classism. Therefore, to proclaim the two together in the slogan "God and Country" is a direct contradiction because God encourages equality through Christ, yet America promotes inequality through capital, thus calling it Democracy.

If America and Christianity is to coexist, the follower of either will have to denounce their devotion to one and serve the other or else they are in transgression of the Word of God. For the confessors of "God and Country" to justify their belief, they must realize that Christianity and the American political and social system does not work in conjunction and they need to seek out the answer to God's proposed government system.

What Jesus says about Tithing

Let us address the biggest untruth that any false preacher has ever told; that when Jesus was here on earth He was rich. Jesus was not rich when He walked the earth. The reason preachers tell people this is that Christianity means Christ-like, and Christians strive to be like Jesus, so preachers say this to get people to start thinking about how to get rich, as they claim Jesus was.

As an example to the flock, the preacher must be a product of his own testimony, so he creates and sells audio and videotapes, and books about how an average believer can inherit the riches of Christ. While the congregation consumes these goods, the preacher gets rich. People never stop to think about what is going on, how the preacher is actually getting rich by selling them things on getting rich, not because God is prospering the preacher with a heavenly inheritance.

We as Christians are rich in righteousness and heavenly fruit, not monetary wealth. A desire to be rich will consume the soul in unnecessary lusts that destroy righteousness and heavenly fruit and with a little spin on biblical concepts and the added touch of the Malachi Theory (will a man rob God); the preacher guarantees his opportunity to be rich. The strategy is like a neighborhood bully's hustle.

Many people seek riches in today's society and many will compromise morals for money, and there will always be crafty villains who will capitalize on that compromise. The sad thing is that the compromise is going on in churches and church leaders are the villains.

The theory of Jesus being rich is taken from the scripture of 2 Corinthians 8:9, among many other implied scriptures, which reads, "For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich." The riches the scripture refer to are spiritual riches not material substances: spiritual riches of glory and honor and righteousness, all attributes of God's kingdom. What need would anyone have of material things in heaven?

In heaven, the bible says the streets are made of gold, the gates are laid in rubies and valuable jewels, and the crowns are made of silver and or gold, but none of these things are used to profit of the other, like it is used in this world; therefore, material substances have no real value compared to the riches of heaven. If people believe monetary things has meaning or value in heaven, then they live in a conceited and materialistic fantasy world.

The Lord desires that His children be rich in the qualities of heavenly riches, where the physical has no value. He did not send His Son, Jesus, to earth to die on the cross to make us rich with substances of the earth: that is a lie and contrary to scripture. "Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break though nor steal" (Matt. 6:19, 20).

The reason preachers teach Christian prosperity on earth is no mystery: it justifies their earthly greed. They stress the deed of tithing constantly because they claim to want to see God's people prosper, but the truth is ten percent of each individual member's monthly earnings from a 10,000 or so member congregation secures the church prosperity and the preacher's, and that is the underlying motive. From time to time, preachers will teach other topics as marriage, faith or family, but again, these topics also have an underlying motive that usually leads up to money.

Jesus walked the earth from city to city preaching righteousness and never asked anyone for a dime. He told the disciples "Provide neither gold, nor silver, nor brass in your purses" (Matt. 10:9). He was instructing them to not be concerned about money, but about preaching the gospel. The purpose of the gospel has nothing to do with money, but salvation: not prosperity, but perfection.

Jesus never asked for tithes from the multitudes, He never took up offerings in the synagogues; He never said anything about being under a curse if people did not pay tithes. One of the disciples would have recorded a New Testament commandment on tithes if Jesus had stressed tithe paying, but He did not. Jesus never wore expensive robes, jewelry, rode in any beautiful carriages, or owned anything of real value that brought relevance to the gospel.

He did not cease to teach against seeking for riches and glory or any of the things of the world. He spoke against fame and fortune and told the disciples that the world would hate them, and would not love them. He fed the multitudes with food of the physical and spiritual nature, and He never charged them money or suggested they give an offering to God for what He taught them. However, this is what today's preachers do.

Another parable that denounces the search for riches and money is in St. Mark chapter 12 vv. 41-44, called the widow's mite. In this parable, Jesus showed that the amount of the widow's offering to the church, which was only two mites, had no heavenly value, but because it was giving her all that won her honor with God. Though others gave more money than the widow did, they gave only a portion of their earnings, which is the concept of tithes, and not all of their earnings.

What the widow did was more acceptable with God than what the others did. The moral of this parable is, the sincerity of a person's commitment to God is counted by what they have to sacrifice, not how much they have. It also proves that God does not care about how much goes into the offering plate, whether a tenth, a fifth, or a twentieth of the giver's earnings, but whatever goes in must come from the heart, and whenever it is financially handy or reasonably logical for the giver.

The parable of the rich fool in St. Luke 12:16-21, is another that talks against the riches of the earth. The rich man's wealth increased abundantly throughout his life to where he was resolved what to do with the riches. His most logical conclusion was to build a bigger barn to store his goods, and then he would lay back and relax the rest of his life, (live off the interest so-called). Not to imply that saving and maybe investing is wrong, but people must make provisions for each aspect of life, which includes the salvation of the soul.

The rich man never considered what would become of his soul on the night he was to die, nor did he think about what would happen to his goods afterward. Many people in the world would leave their estate to heirs, so the heirs can carry the burden. Nevertheless, Jesus said that it is not wise to "Layeth up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God" (v. 21). How does a person become rich toward God? They seek after the things of God, which are spiritual.

The parable of the hidden treasure in St. Matthew 13:44 is about a man who stumbles upon the treasures of heaven in a field and hides them for himself, then he goes and sells all that is of earthly wealth to him and buys the field. The man counted the riches of the earth nothing compared to the riches of heaven.

This mentality is what Jesus tries to relay to believers, to not trust in and depend on the treasures of earth but instead the treasures of heaven. Yet, preachers are not teaching this mentality to believers today, they are teaching them to seek the treasures of heaven in material form here on earth.

A deceptive spirit is affecting the church today that suggests a change of plans according to Jesus, which is; no more does He want believers to wait for heaven to get the treasures of heaven, but He will give believers the treasures of heaven in the form of earthly riches, and people believe this spirit. Believers must remember that "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever" (Heb. 13:8). He has not changed.

The parable of the goodly pearl in St. Matthew 13:45, 46 teaches the same as the parable of the hidden treasure, however, in this one, the man found a great pearl, instead of treasures, and sold all that he had to buy the pearl. Preachers take these two parables and twist the meanings: they teach that the moral of the parables is that in order to get the treasures of heaven believers must give all their material things, including earnings, to God, or at least to the one who represents God, which is the preacher. Yet, the preacher's definition of the riches of heaven means material things, not spiritual.

The parables' meaning of the riches of heaven means spiritual things, not material. Preachers convince believers that the riches of heaven are the material things of earth, that is, if the believer wants the riches of heaven in earthly form. However, the parables do not confirm the message in the preacher's perspective because it is not a literal theme, it is the essence of a mentality, which confirms the essence of heaven and not earth.

Because the parables use riches and treasures as illustrations, preachers take it to the literal realm to justify their lust for material goods, riches, and wealth, and because this spirit has infected society and the church, people believe in the literal and choose not the spiritual.

The parable of the Prodigal Son in St. Luke 15:11-32 is a beautiful illustration of the spirit that encourages believers to get treasures of heaven here on earth. The son asked his wealthy father for his share of the inheritance then left home and spent it all on riotous living, women, and excess of wine. When he hit rock bottom and came to his senses he returned home. His father forgave him and gave the son another inheritance simply because his father felt the son learned a valuable lesson.

The lesson was that the son never had to ask for his share of the inheritance in the first place, all he had to do was live and be content, but the son's longing for the substances and pleasures of the world overtook him and he wasted his inheritance until he came to shame.

Many people do not realize that when asking God for their share of the inheritance in the earthly form of material goods and so-called blessings of God that they are asking amiss and in covetousness, also because the pastor has convinced them to get what is theirs. If given the chance to have all that God grants in one lump sum could be dangerous because the deceitfulness of riches choke and destroy the goodness of the heart.

Countless parables of the New Testament plainly condemn the pursuance of money and today's pastors choose to ignore those parables. The reason people continue to follow misleading preachers is that people do not read their bibles, so they will never see or believe preachers are deceiving them.

The parables of Jesus Christ not only warn believers of falling into the mentality of the love of money, but also are lessons of how to gain and keep the riches of heaven, which are spiritual fruits of the heart and soul, not the pocket. Common sense must govern the followers of Christ concerning what things are destructive in the world. The love of money is one of the most destructive, so believers must know to be suspicious of a preacher who places great emphasis on money.

People are willing to believe that God wants to make them rich before He does anything to their soul when the scripture plainly says "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you" (Matt. 6:33). The righteousness of God comes first and during the believer's search for righteousness, He supplies the necessities of life and adds to the believer financial needs for the ministry.

Another scripture preachers use to heighten the lust for money is "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth" (3 John 2). Preachers constantly twist this scripture out of proportion until there is no more substance, meaning, or creditableness to the scripture. The only reason they use this scripture is to convince people that God wants them to prosper, and it is true. This is what the scripture says and the Scriptures are true.

However, God no more gives prosperity than He does allow people to prosper. But what about the rest of the scripture, like good health? If the love of health was the root of all evil, and health influenced a person's status in society, preachers would be aerobic stars. Good health is in the scripture also and is what God desires for His people so what about the congregation's health? There are Old Testament ordinances for diet as are Old Testament ordinances for tithing, but preachers do not emphasize the ordinances of diet in their sermons. What profit would that bring?

There is no tithe for the sake of good health and a good diet alone will not get a soul into heaven. If a believer does not maintain a good diet or good health, is it a sin? No, but preachers do not teach this, although they teach the curse of tithes. What do the Scriptures say about eating fried foods and fatty foods?

What does the scripture say about too much sugar or too much grease and butter in food: things that kill the body? There is no church offering for the medical ministry nor do churches ordain men and women as ministers of health and fitness, (at least not as of yet) but they keep records of member tithes. Why focus on only one half of a scripture?

The Bible admonishes believers not to fall for these racketeering games of earthly riches. Follow righteousness, faith, and love, as the Bible says. Believers should never study and search the Scriptures for theories of obtaining money but search the Scriptures to obtain eternal life and prosperity will follow. Give only what is affordable at the time to the church and let God do the rest.

No preacher should ever burden believers with the guilt of sin and curses because they neglect or refuse to tithe to the church, but preachers must encourage believers to give what is affordable and financially convenient for the believer. "For if there be first a willing mind, it is accepted according to that a man hath, and not according to that he hath not" (2 Cor. 8:12).

Neither Jesus nor the apostles ever mention anything to the believers about tithing. They stressed and practiced giving. To give according to what he or she has or giving all that he or she has (to a trustworthy believer only) is necessary, but never a portion or a tenth. This is the mentality the Lord desires for His children to possess. Believers are under no biblical duty to contribute at all and preachers should not compel them to do so.

However, a believer should give to the church for the operation of the physical church building including utilities, food for gatherings, and other necessary things for everyday operation. Preachers insist that people are required to give, that it is mandatory of God and if they do not give money to the church then they are cursed. This is not the purpose of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

The scripture says, "Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver" (2 Cor. 9:7). This scripture confirms that believers are under no direct obligation or commandment to give anything to the church but what they have determined in their own heart to give. Preachers should never pressure believers to give money to the church, and believers should never feel they have to because they will then give grudgingly.

When preachers teach the above scripture they twist its meaning and interpret it thus: "a person should give according to what they have purposed in their heart but we all know that God requires a tenth, so in

addition to the tenth, the person should give a little more." They add tithing in as if tithing is a given, but this is not true. The church of Jesus Christ does not have to tithe.

Preachers give believers no choice but to follow their lead, and right back into the commandments of the Law. No preacher will ever tell the believer to give only what they feel is right, but the preacher will always stress the deed of tithing along with a little extra from the goodness of the believer's heart. Many times, the preacher will ask for tithes, an offering, a love offering, a contribution for the building fund, a donation for the family in isle two, a gift offering for the couple engaged, and they ask all in the name of building the work of God and the church ministry.

There is no end to extortion for church money, and as believers grow in the righteousness and spirituality of God, they will see that there is no limit to how and on what bases the false prophet will solicit church members.

The Root of All Evil

The Bible states, "For the love of money is the root of all evil" 1 Timothy 6:10. It does not say that money is the root of all evil, but the love of money is the root of all evil. Many of today's Christians will defy all natural law, human logic and biblical doctrine to justify the innocents of earthy riches and defend why their pastor drives a Bentley, lives in a multimillion dollar home, and travels in a personal jet.

People believe that there is nothing wrong with being rich and prosperous beyond the average person's wildest dream, however, there is something wrong with it. In fact, the rich were not spoken of to highly by Jesus during his ministry, but were always warned of hording money while neglecting their salvation. Some would reason that a person could have both, but that thinking also defies biblical reasoning.

"Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself. But godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. And having food and raiment let us be therewith content. But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition." 1 Timothy 6:5-9.

According to the above words, it would be better to be content with food and raiment than to be rich because riches lead to many temptations. But how many of today's Christians actually quote and practice this logic. They believe, do, and teach the exact opposite and so do many church leaders. To think that money and riches is innocent in the fight for salvation is ludicrous and hurtful to the soul.

What is so disheartening to see are church members who throw money on the pulpit while the pastor is preaching? This show is displayed much on televangelist ministries and is an abomination in the face of the above concept of scripture. SHREVEPORT, La. - Greenwood Acres Full Gospel Baptist Church will pay white people to attend services during August to increase the diversity of its congregation.

Bishop Fred Caldwell says he will pay \$5 per hour for Sunday services and \$10 an hour for the Thursday service. The idea came to him during his sermon Sunday.

"Our churches are too segregated, and the Lord never intended for that to happen. It's time for something radical," Caldwell says.

He is basing the initiative on a parable from Matthew 20:1-16, the story of the workers in the vineyard. A landowner hired men to work in his fields for the day and throughout the day kept seeking more workers. No matter what time they came to work, the workers were all paid the same.

Revelations on the Rapture

The Rapture is an event Christians regard as the day when the Lord Jesus Christ returns for His church, the body of Christ. The event unfolds like this: it will be a normal day and the world will be operating as every other day, when suddenly all Christians will disappear from the very spot they are standing before the eyes and to the amazement of anyone around them. If the Christian happens to be driving a car, the car will veer out of control after it is abandoned. If two people are standing at a water cooler and one is a Christian, the Christian will miraculously disappear and their clothes will drop to the floor.

Where will they go? They "shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air" (1 Thessalonians 4:17), and those who are not Christians, or did not have Jesus as their Savior (according to the popular doctrine) will be left standing and wishing they had received Him. From that time, the world will go into total chaos trying to understand this phenomenon. Husbands and wives, children, co-workers and friends will suffer the lost of loved ones to a force beyond their understanding. While this event is suppose to bring many to a realization that Christ is real, there will also be many skeptics attempting to explain this event in scientific terms.

Church leaders have accepted this rendition of how the Lord, at His Second Coming, will come to receive His people and leaders have termed it the Rapture. Bible scholars have written books, correlated together through biblical doctrine to confirm the same theory. As a result of this acceptance, Christian stores sale merchandise like tee-shirts and bumper-stickers that blurb witting sayings about the Rapture, such as "in the event of a Rapture, this car will be out of control," and "beam me up Jesus." The Christian world has settled with this explanation of the Second Coming of the Lord and not many of today's church leaders have searched for anything deeper.

However, when pondering this theory seriously, and in terms of the abilities and power of God, the Rapture theory cannot possibly reveal what will really happen. Inevitably, there will be a Second Coming of Christ, and true Christians will be caught up in the clouds to meet the Lord, because this is what the Bible says, but it will not happen as scholars say it will and churchgoers expect. They left out a few obviously logical details. First, the word "Rapture" is not in the Bible at all. This fact automatically subtracts from the theory and blissful description the word Rapture imparts, which is joy, ecstasy, and the bliss of a seventh heaven, which sounds good and what the scholars intended to provoke, a state of ecstasy. Nevertheless, is this ecstasy what the Second Coming will bring?

Despite man's fantastic imagination and wishful thinking, along with his misinterpretation of God's Word, the Second Coming of Christ - according to the Bible- will only be blissful to those Jesus comes for. The day will begin as normal, but a preceding event must first take place before the His arrival. In fact, this preceding event will be the reason He comes again. Scholars seem to view Jesus as a magician who performs feats of "the eye being quicker than the hand" leaving the audience astounded, which is where they make their mistake. Though the Lord does astound people, He rarely does it with showy antics. God works the opposite way of man's mind, which is why men cannot perceive Him wholly.

When a person is looking for Him to come from the left, He comes from the right. When they look for Him from the east, He comes from the west. In the case of the Rapture, or Second Coming, Christians are expecting to be taken before the eyes of the world leaving the world in repentance and shame, but when the Lord returns to gather His people, the rest of the world will not see it because it is the soul, not the body that He is coming for. The scripture says that, "flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption" (1 Corinthians 15:50). If He comes for the soul and not the body, any logical person would reason that in the case of the Rapture, the clothes would not be the only things that fall to the ground; if the soul is gone then the body will fall also. And if there are 50 million Christians in the world, there will be 50 million dead bodies on the ground. Though this too may seem like an alternate Rapture theory, neither is this what will happen.

Many church leaders will quote the scripture that says, "we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye" (1 Corinthians 15:51, 52), to justify that the body will be taken and then changed in mid air once we meet the Lord. However, the scripture also says that this body is of the earth must return from whence it came, back to the earth, therefore, how can the body be changed and returned to the earth at the same time? This is where believers must study the Word and pray fervently for understanding. Many church leaders know that Christians do not study, as they should - and neither do they -so they continue to teach this illogical and imaginative theory, neither themselves searching for deeper meaning. Well, what is the deeper meaning?

In Romans chapter 7, vs.-25, Paul uncovers a plot that his flesh has set for his spirit man. He discovers a war in his members, in which the will of his flesh is warring against the will of the Holy Spirit within him, bringing him into captive to the laws of sin and unrighteousness. In deeper meaning, Paul reveals the two natures of humankind, the fleshly and the spiritual being within man: the flesh being the body and the Holy Spirit in man being a reflection of the person's soul. One who has received the gift of the Holy Spirit has a desire from the Spirit to conform their soul into what God desires them to be. This is where Paul found a serious fight, to regain control of and the destiny of his soul. The Holy Spirit is the power that will "Rapture" the soul of the Christian and if there is no Holy Spirit in the Christian, the soul of the person is then lost. The Lord is not interested in the flesh because the flesh is that which he wants to destroy. Therefore, if the flesh is left to die on earth it is no great lost.

If one understands that there are two natures within a single person, especially and actually, in a Christian, then they must realize that both the body and the soul cannot return when the Lord comes to receive His people. Furthermore, it is natural and written law that the body must return to the earth from whence it came because it was sown from the earth and cannot bare the image of the heavenly (1 Corinthians 15:44- 49). So now, where are we in terms of the "Rapture" theory? If suddenly the Lord returns one day, and He - because of His own word - cannot take the body because we as Christians "must put off this body" and 50 million dead bodies around the world appears nowhere in the written word of God as prophesy, then the Rapture theory has no validity.

Other church leaders will argue the point that the scripture says at the coming of the Lord, "Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left" (St. Matthew 24:40, 41). They use these scriptures to justify that the Rapture theory is accurate according to what the Bible says. However, how accurate and God-like is this concept. What is its actual meaning? In the parable, it may seem that there are two people together doing whatever it is they are doing, but spiritually, it is only one person but with the two natures, Paul talked of in Romans chapter seven when he explains the war of the flesh and of the spirit.

In Corinthians chapter 15, the scripture says that there is a natural man and there is a spiritual man, and that the natural must come before the spiritual in all things (vv.46). We as humans were born first of the flesh, of the natural body, and when we are born again we are born of the spirit and have a spiritual body, or are attempting to build a spiritual body. When a person has gone through the second birth, by being born again of water and of the spirit, they are daily attempting to change the inner-man or fleshly-man into a spiritual man, thus there is a war within their souls of the two natures.

In the Second Coming of the Lord, He will take the spiritual man and leave the natural. He will take the reborn-man and leave the sinner man. This is the revelation of the field in St. Matthew 24. The one will be taken and the other left. The spiritual man will be taken and the natural man left behind. This biblical theory and revelation makes void the theory of bible scholars who have not searched the spiritual depths of God. Following this train of thought, it seems there will be dead bodies all over if God comes only for the spiritual man and not the natural. However, we must go deeper into the scriptures to find out what happens to the natural bodies when Jesus comes for His church, and what happens to the rest of the world who had not the new birth.

In 2 Peter 3: 4-10, the Bible explains that the world will not be destroyed by water the second time but by fire. It says "But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass

away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with a fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up" (vv. 10). Again, many preachers will relate this passage of scripture to the end, after the Great Throne Judgment, but the passage distinctly says "the day of the Lord" which is the day of Jesus, not God, and the day of Jesus is the day of the Second Coming. So if on the day of the Lord the earth and the works of the earth, meaning all things made from the earth, will be burned up, that means that some force of an immense heat will cause this traumatic destruction of humankind. What could it be?

Either man will destroy himself with the inventions of nuclear arms, or some falling asteroid from space will hit the earth. Nevertheless, so God can remain a righteous God, He will not be the one to be blamed by man of man's destruction, but as written in the article Prepare to Survive, God will allow man to destroy himself. Know the Truth About Salvation

INTRODUCTION

With so many religions in the world today, and numerous denominations in the United States alone, the chances of finding the absolute truth comes down to those who sincerely want it. An open mind is not the only thing needed in a search for the truth but an open heart that holds a desire for the knowledge of God, and a simple belief in the words that have been recorded about Him.

Know the Truth rightly divides the precepts of the Holy Bible in order to render a clearer picture of the will of God for everyone's soul salvation. Without complicated theories or hype about how to be saved, the booklet remains simple enough for even a child to understand. Again, all that is required on the part of the reader is faith in the word and promises of God, not in the author.

"And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, Lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him: And a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased" (St. Matthew 3:16, 17).

The above scripture gives us all the perfect example of what it takes to please God, born again of water, and of the Spirit. After John baptized Jesus, and the Holy Spirit of God came upon him, God made it known that he was well pleased in his Son. Before this blessed event took place, in verse 15 Jesus reminded John that he must be baptized of him in order to "fulfill all righteousness." To be righteous means to be in right standing with God, and Jesus gave us the beginning fruits of acceptance into the kingdom of God. Furthermore, God acknowledged Jesus as his Son and this is what it truly means to be a child of God.

Common sense - and the word of God - will reveal anyone that there is only one possible way to get to the kingdom of God. Regardless of the different world religions and theories of salvation, and the various doors to the kingdom many church denominations have left open, God has but one door to His kingdom, and it was unlocked by His first-born son Jesus Christ.

The actual event of Jesus and John the Baptist is again, the foundation to salvation. Born again of water and of the Spirit completes salvation as required by God. No other method can precede this act of the new birth. Different church denominations will veer around this act with their own interpretation of salvation only because they fear the truth, or do not know the truth. Therefore, they try to make it easier for a soul to enter by proclaiming such false doctrines like accepting the Lord as your personal Savior and they will be saved, and of course, they back this theory with a scripture in which we will dissect later in the booklet. Nevertheless, the truth is, the leaders who teach this theory have themselves taken the easy way out.

Certain churches tell you that the first step is to get saved, then to get born again, which is not only a false doctrine but contradicts the scriptures. Once a person is born again of water and of the Spirit, they are saved. This is what will save them from going to hell. When the Holy Spirit of God descends down into a person, the same Spirit will resurrect them at his gathering of believers. A person cannot be saved then get the Holy Spirit, for it is the Holy Spirit that saves.

"Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost" (Titus 3:5).

Along with this scripture, there are other scriptures to confirm the one and only new birth. The believer must rightly divide the word of truth in order to get the full picture of salvation and not assume the theories of an unlearned teacher. No amount of good deeds, tithes or offerings, faithfulness in church attendance, hours of bible study, or any other almsgiving acts can substitute for the correct method of salvation.

"Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God" (St. John 3:3). "Verily, verily I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God" (St John 3:5).

The word baptism comes from the Greek word "Baptizo" which means "to make fully wet: to wash." To be made fully wet - as Jesus was when John baptized him - one must go down into a body of water - and he "came straightway up out of the water" (verse 16), after John totally submerged him into the water making him fully wet. This is the actual, physical way that a person is to be baptized, not sprinkled or splashed, neither is it only symbolic. If it were only a symbol Jesus would not have done it physically.

The spiritual meaning for being water baptized is to wash away your old sin nature. We were all born into sin and are considered sinners by nature. Even if a person has never broken any of the original Ten Commandments, they are still considered sinners and must be regenerated by the water baptism. You repent for the immoral acts of sin that you consciously commit and then get water baptized in order to wash them away. "Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life" (Romans 6:4). Thus, the water baptism begins for a person the start of a sinless life.

Another misconception in the doctrine of water baptism is the name in which it is to be done. Traditional churches teach from the scripture of St. Matthew 28:19, in which Jesus commissioned the disciples to go and baptize all nations in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. However, let us search the scriptures and see what name the disciples used when they started baptizing people. In the book of Acts after the believers received the Holy Ghost on the day of Pentecost, and after Peter preached to them what was prophesied of Joel concerning the Christ, a group of men asked Peter: "Men and brethren, what shall we do?" Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost" (Acts 2:37, 38). Peter plainly stated to the men that they should be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. He did not say in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Why? Because the Holy Ghost revealed to Peter that Jesus was, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost.

Another example of the baptism in Jesus name is recorded in Acts 10:48 when Peter baptized other believers who had received the Holy Ghost but had not yet been baptized. "And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord." And who is Lord? Jesus Christ is Lord. Not only did the disciples baptize in the name of Jesus Christ, they did many other miracles of the kingdom in his name. "Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk" (Acts 3:6).

Paul cast out a demon from a woman who mocked at them for many days, and he did it in the name of Jesus Christ. Acts 16:18. All power is given to Jesus Christ and everything that is to be done in the will of God is to be done in the name of Jesus Christ. The only reason some churches teach the title of the

Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost, is because they have not the true revelation of the Spirit or who the Christ really is, they only rely on intellectual understanding of God, not Spiritual understanding. They fear the supernatural powers that come within the essence of the Holy Ghost and from the authority of Jesus Christ, which is also why they make up alternative ways of salvation, because of the fear of truth.

In the book of Acts 19:1-7, Paul had run across a group of believers who had been water baptized by John's baptism - which was the baptism of repentance - and had not yet received the gift of the Holy Ghost. They told Paul that they had not even heard of the Holy Ghost, but they were only believers of the Christ. They had a zeal for righteousness and they believed in the baptism of John, but Paul told them that John preached of believing in the one that would come after him, which was Jesus Christ. Then the scripture reads: "And when they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied" (Acts 19:6).

Another reason church leaders today avoid the true gospel is because they do not believe in speaking in tongues after receiving the Holy Ghost. Speaking in other tongues is not only a gift of the Holy Spirit, but also a confirmation of receiving God. The scripture reveals tongues (which is spoken of throughout the New Testament) as one of the many attributes of God. It is ordained of God and a part of the new birth. Tongues are a way the Spirit within you communicates with God after the new birth. "Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercessions for us with groanings which cannot be uttered" (Romans 8:26).

The Spirit baptism, the Holy Ghost, or, the Holy Spirit is all the same thing. To be born of the Spirit is to receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. Jesus promised the disciples and all that believe on him this precious gift. It is the actual essence of God inside of you - if you receive it. It is real. Many people do not believe in things they cannot see so they take for granted the presence of the Holy Ghost. A ghost is a spirit, and God is a spirit, so people actually take God for granted because there is no evidence of his presence. However, the Spirit of God shows much infallible evidence. It takes a sincere belief in the Spirit in order for it to show itself to you, or come inside you. A person must be ready to receive it and the gifts and supernatural powers that it brings with it, and must not fear. If one believes in the Spirit and desires for it to enter them, then it will come; it is a promise of Jesus Christ. It will come inside your body, bring to life your soul, and illuminate your mind that you may see the evidence of God. Afterward, you will know beyond a doubt that God is real.

The Holy Ghost does not appear once then goes away. It stays with you forever. After you receive it, wherever you may be, it will be there in the morning when you awake. The world has stereotyped the receiving of the Holy Ghost into a picture of people running and jumping and shouting out of control, and many people react this way because they feel they should live up to this enactment. Nevertheless, one can receive the Holy Ghost as quietly and calmly as the Lord gives it. Because of this stereotyped picture of the Holy Ghost, many are frightened away from receiving it. In a way, you could say that the church could be responsible for discouraging many potential believers because of the show they put on in church.

False prophets have also given the powers of the Holy Ghost a bad name by displaying pretentious shows of healing and casting out of demonic spirits. These acts were also done in the days of the early apostles' where unsaved men would use the authority of Jesus' name to cast out devils, which in turn discredited the apostle's true demonstrations of the power of God. Yet, the Holy Ghost is given sincerely to those

who seek sincerely. Those who understand its authority use the powers sincerely, and the gifts of the Spirit operate correctly for those who practice them correctly. "Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you" (St. Matthew 7:7).

"Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them" (St. Mark 11:24).

The Holy Ghost is the Spirit of God and God is love. It is the Spirit of truth, and Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life. The Holy Ghost is a comforter; one that will keep you focused in the times of life's trials and tribulations; though hard times of pain and heartaches. It gives you joy in the mist of corruption; it gives you peace in the mist of confusion. It makes you humble and meek in the face of arrogance and pride. It fills your heart and mind with the characteristics of righteousness when evil attempts to consume you. It gives faith to trust in the promises of God when the situation gets beyond your understanding and control, to remind you that He will always provide for you and never leave you barren or without daily encouragement.

The Holy Ghost strengthens you in the presence of all your enemies and gives you the victory over all the works of the adversary. He (the Holy Ghost) is a teacher of truth so you will never believe a lie. He is a guide on the road of salvation so that you do not go astray under the deceptions of the devil. He protects you from all evil; heals you from sicknesses, and delivers you from your own sins and iniquities. Give Him the chance and He will solve all the problems in your life. The fruits and gifts of the Spirit are all attributes of God that a person cannot experience unless they have received the Spirit. There are cases where a person might practice forms of witchcraft using the forces of the spiritual world, powers of the dominion of the spiritual realm of the kingdom of God. Every gift must, or should be, used in a manner that exalts the kingdom of God. The Spirit perfects that which is lacking in a soul by molding it into a form of righteousness and goodness, which has a power all its own.

The things that cannot be seen with the natural eye can be seen in the Spirit. A spiritual person can perform things that cannot be done by the natural man. "But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God" (1 Corinthians 2:9, 10).

"Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offense unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men" (St. Matthew 16:23).

When men begin to make up their own ways of entering the kingdom of God, they begin to err from the truth of Gods word. Some men alter the truth of salvation in order to gain followers; they figure that many people - as they are - refuse to believe in something they cannot see and would rather worship gods according to their own desires. In other words, they want the easy way out and there are many false teachers who adhered to their wishes. Thus fulfilling the scripture of 2 Timothy 4:3,4. Please read. There is only one way to be saved; to enter the kingdom of God; to go to heaven, and that is to be born again of water and of the Spirit.

The most popular method taught of getting saved by unlearned traditional preachers comes from the scripture in Romans 10:9 which reads: "That if thou confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus Christ, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." All scripture is true and profitable for doctrine yet a follower of the gospel must rightly divide the Word of truth.

The 10th chapter of Romans was dedicated to the unbelieving Jews who rejected Christ as the Savior of the world. They first had to recognize this fact in order for them to begin the process of salvation. This confession of Christ as the Savior can be done, and has been done, by the devil himself; but this does not mean that he will be saved. The devil knows that God raised Christ from the dead and that Christ is the Savior of humanity, yet his destiny is already planned; he cannot be saved. The scripture in James 2:19 reads: "Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble." It is a shame that even the devil knows there is a god (and many people acknowledge the devil) but people will not believe in the powers and salvation of the Lord.

Anyone can confess though mere words have no meaning if you do not have faith. The devil will stand before a crowd and say; "Yes, I confess with my mouth and believe in my heart." but this does not guarantee salvation. The confession and belief are elementary to bring you to salvation, and eventually you will be saved. Further down in Romans verse 13 it reads:"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." Again, this act is one that jump-starts your faith of God. Once you conclude that you truly believe and desire to live for the Lord, and then you seek and ask for the gift of the Holy Ghost. Only after you receive the gift of the Holy Ghost, and are water baptized in the name of Jesus Christ, will you be saved. "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarded of them that diligently seek him" (Hebrews 11:6).

So you can confess, believe, and call on his name, the devil does all those things also, but unless one receives the gift of the Holy Ghost, to be born again, you will not enter the kingdom of God. The difference is thin and it takes a sincere soul to understand the truth; one who really wants to know God and not just to pretend he is saved, or to belong to the trendiest church scene. It is also difficult to know the true believers from the false, but one who has received the gift of the Spirit should be able to recognize the wolves in sheep's clothing and their teachings of false doctrine.

After the Holy Ghost is received by anyone, the gifts will begin to appear. "And these signs shall follow them that believe; in my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover" (St. Mark 16:17, 18). It takes faith and belief in these scriptures in order for them to manifest. Any of the gifts of the Spirit takes faith in order to operate. Moreover, in order for your faith to operate properly, you must have love; and God is love. God is also a Spirit. Therefore, if you receive the Holy Spirit of God you can manifest the gifts of the Spirit through love.

Today's' Christian do not operate in the gifts of the Spirit like they should because they find it a bit embarrassing to go around claiming to have supernatural powers. Many Christians have even received the Holy Ghost yet fail to bring forth the faith to operate in the gifts. The truth is they are afraid they will be mocked by the world that stereotype and classify those who operate in the gifts as belonging to a cult. "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him" (St. John 4:23). Both spirit and truth are required of a believer after they receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. Worship of God consists of an adoration of God. A desire to know Him and His will for your life. A desire to be molded into the image of His Son Jesus Christ: a desire to be righteous according to the standard of God's righteousness, not your own: to seek the heavenly powers of good, and not evil, and to use those powers to bring others into the faith of God. Worship of God enables a believer to realize things as they truly are and not the illusions of the world: to accept the truth even in the time of doubt: to know the truth and uphold it in the face of persecution by millions of others, in the face of mockery and contempt by those who seek to deceive you. One must speak the truth when pain may be the result, yet speaking it in love and hope of salvation, not as a cloak of maliciousness.

A true worshipper of God never compromises the truth for a portion of this world's wealth or glory or status, (like thousands of preachers are doing today, and have done throughout history). A true worshipper knows the standard of God and lifts it up against the devil. A true worshipper is hated by the world, not loved; family members and close friends because of his devotion and adoration of his Lord despise him. True worshippers accept the necessary things of life with great contentment rejoice in the joy, peace, and love that he receives of the Lord everyday. He is constantly learning new things about the kingdom of God and never rest at the price of deception. He loves the saints of God so deeply that he, like Jesus, would give his life to save them. He has a never-ending hope for those that are lost and blind to the deceptions of Satan, that they will some day know, just how deep the love of God runs.

"And hope maketh not ashamed, because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us" (Romans 5:5). The plan of the devil is to sidetrack anyone he can, as long as he can, from knowing the truth. So many preachers these days have been trained and taught by older preachers who themselves were deceived that it is very difficult discerning who is telling the truth any more. Many people use this excuse for not going to church but at the day you stand before God, and he opens the lambs book of life, (which is the New Testament), and begin to recite the scriptures to you, you will be condemned by your own resistance to the truth, because the truth is written in His Word.

No one can blame the church or the preachers who preach false doctrine for the damnation of millions of souls on that day; only you will be able to answer for your own soul salvation. Since people choose to hear what they want to hear, and live the Christian life the way they feel is acceptable to God, not only will you be condemned by lack of faith in His Word, but you will be convicted of crucifying the Son of God: along with all the preachers who neglected to acknowledge the truth in this age of mercy and Gods grace.

Remember that you must be born again!

Tithing: In the Age of Grace

INTRODUCTION

Tithing in the age of Grace searches each phase of tithing throughout the bible. As the giving of a tenth to Melchezedek by Abraham, as an inheritance to the tribe of Levi during the period of the Law, these two theories cover the Old Testament. The coming of Christ and his standpoint on tithing, the early church and their methods of receiving money, up unto today's church and in what ways it practices tithing.

The book of Hebrews thoroughly covers the first two stages of tithing, which will be studied in the first portion of this booklet. The second portion of this booklet will examine Christ's stand on tithing along with other relevant scriptures in the New Testament. By the end of the composition, the reader should be able to endorse his or her own judgment in the matter. By testimony of the word itself and through the inward unction of the teaching of the Spirit of Truth, (the Holy Ghost); to discern whether or not the church of Jesus Christ should be tithing in the age of Grace.

Part one - Hebrews

Chapters 6-11 of the book of Hebrews cover the theory of Christ being the high priest of God forever after the order of Melchisedec. Within a thorough analysis of the theory, there is a divine enlightenment concerning the duty of tithing as it pertains to the followers of Christ. In order to unfold the revelation, we will follow each passage and precept beginning with chapter 6, verse 1 of Hebrews. (In order to preserve space and for the reader to get full confirmation of this study, the author asks that the reader have the Word of God opened to the selected text).

In chapter 6:1-3, the writer of Hebrews admonishes the saints to leave the principles of the doctrine of Christ and go on unto perfection. "And this will we do, if God permit." verse three. There are levels of growth within the walk of the gospel and in order to leave the principles of the doctrine of Christ, the beginning level, one has to first be rooted in the doctrine. Having understanding of each of the above basics of the doctrine; repentance, faith in God, baptisms, spiritual gifts, the resurrection of the dead and of the judgment, the saint can then grow into the perfecting stage of the gospel.

Once a believer is rooted in the doctrine, they cannot be uprooted or led astray after the Lord directs them into their calling, to perform Gods will for them in their life. The beginning phase (the one of grounding), is to mold the believer for the work in which God has called them, and this is the central meaning for the first 3 verses in chapter 6. An understanding of this message will be needed, and referred back to, as we go further into this search.

Verses 4-8, in its revealed meaning, simply admonishes the believer of the consequences to reap if one never advances from the basics if the doctrine of Christ in order to go on unto perfection. They fail to bring forth a harvest of the gospel and is nigh unto cursing, because they have crucified Christ in their refusal to enter into the perfecting phase of the gospel; moreover, they never fulfill the will of God for them in their lives. Verses 9-12 encourage the believer to continue on in the gospel through faith and patience in order to obtain the promises of God.

With this basic foundation laid by the first 12 verses of chapter 6, we hope that the reader has found himself to be rooted in the gospel and ready to go on unto perfection. In order to obtain perfection, the believer must be ready to remove from them, any burdens of the Law and press forward into the true gospel, which comes only by faith and grace in Christ. The following passages and precepts of the next five chapters will confirm this advancement.

In verses 13-17, it can be confirmed that the scriptures resort back to the promise made by God to Abraham, in which God blessed and multiplied him. God confirmed it by an oath, seeing there was no higher authority to swear by, thus establishing the fact that all of the heirs after Abraham would also inherit the blessing. Verses 18-20 holds that it is impossible for God to lie which give the heirs of the promise all the more reason to pursue the promise, especially if the forerunner, (Jesus Christ), has paved the way for us, "made high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec." verse 20.

In conclusion of chapter 6, we have established the fact that a believer must, at some point in their walk of the gospel, leave off the principles and move on unto perfection. There is a clear distinction here that there is more than one phase of understanding God, if one does not advance from the beginning level then there would be no way for them to appreciate the next level, not to mention it being difficult to understand.

The scriptures encourage the believer to follow after the promises of God as an heir of the blessing to Abraham - made without a doubt by God and under the influence of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ who went before us into the veil as an high priest making intercession for our sins. With this in agreement we will continue on.

Chapter 7, verses 1-4, renders a complete explanation of the role of Melchisedec who received an offering from Abraham, a tenth of the spoils he [Abraham] acquired after destroying the kings who had taken his nephew captive. According to scripture, Melchisedec was considered the high priest of God, made like unto the Son of God, and initiated the deed of tithing as it first appeared in scripture. It represented honoring God with the first fruits of any goods gained by anyone due to instruction and assistance from God.

The incident involving Melchisedec and Abraham represented the proposed plan for the heirs of Abraham - the twelve tribes of Israel and all those who pursue the promises of God - to honor God with the first fruits of anything material obtained by the heir and as a result of instruction or assistance from God. As we continue on in the search, we must remember that the incident between the two, Melchisedec and Abraham first set the foundation for the bases of the Levitical priesthood made under the Law.

"And verily they that are of the sons of Levi, who receive the office of the priesthood, have a commandment to take tithes of the people according to the law, that is, of their brethren, though they come out of the loins of Abraham." verse 5.

As far as being made like unto the Son of God, verse six explains how, although Melchisedec did not come from the loins of Abraham since he existed before Abraham, he received tithes from Abraham and was inspired by God to bless him. Thus, establishing Melchisedec's authority with God, moreover, revealing the omnipotence of God by implementing the fact that Melchisedec was God. This, afterward, formed the foundation of the following dispensation as it pertains to offering to God. Verse seven simply forms a law of nature not to be disputed.

Verse eight distinguishes mortality from immortality along with a clear establishing of carnality from spirituality, an understanding which will be needed in order to fully understand the principles involving tithing under the age of grace. The differences must be understood because as we continue on, the scriptures will reveal that the law is carnal but grace is spiritual.

The Levite died under the law while practicing carnal ordinances and all under grace worship continually by the power of an endless life; therefore, anything carnal has no part within the realm of spirituality or immortality. Verse nine, 10 reveal the fact that the law was being established, (particularly the law of tithing), before Levi was even born; nevertheless, it was counted as in effect when Abraham gave a tenth to Melchisedec.

Verse 11 is interpreted thus; there would have been no need for Jesus to die on the cross in order to bring the saints to perfection if the Levitical priesthood established perfection, or from under the law. If, on the other hand, perfection did come by the law, then we all, unto this day, would be called to be priest the same way Aaron was a priest.

Verse 12, (and this is an imperative thought), clearly state that there must be a change in the law - which involved tithing - if there is a change in the priesthood. The fact that Jesus is now the high priest after the order of Melchisedec means that tithing, under the law of ordinances, is of no effect in the age of grace. But, to further prove this theory, we will continue on with our analysis.

Verses 13-23 are actually self-explanatory and self-evident. First of all, it proves that Jesus came not only to fulfill the law, but, in many instances to disannul the law. Because the law could make any one perfect - and perfection is the purpose of his coming in the making of disciples and followers - the law proved to be unprofitable by reason of death. The Levitical priesthood had to be passed down generation after generation because it was a carnal priesthood.

But now that Jesus is the high priest after the order of Melchisedec, who has the power of an endless life, the priesthood is established eternally and does not require carnal offerings and sacrifices. These verses also verify the fact that Jesus was not even born into the tribe of Levi but into the tribe of Judah, therefore, he was not chronologically authorized by the law to take the office of a priest. Furthermore, with an oath, Jesus was made the high priest by God, unlike Melchisedec and the Levitical priest, and this oath was to establish perfection, and not by the written law, but by the New Testament which is justified by spirituality not carnality, or carnal ordinances.

Verses 24-28 confirms the fact that Jesus has an unchangeable priesthood which is unlike the Levitical priesthood because the Levitical priest possessed infirmities that needed supplementing by way of daily sacrifices, first for their own individual sins, and then for the sins of the people.

They had to come to the altar each day and offer sacrifice in exchange for the forgiveness of the sins they committed each day. But Jesus, who offered himself one time for the sins of everyone committed from here on out, and does not require different high priest to offer daily, is surly a better testament of salvation, confirmed by an oath from God.

During the next three chapters we will focus on selected verses, and we will confirm the ideas by way of passages related to the ideas. For instance, verse two of chapter 8 reveal that the priesthood of Christ was established by God and not by man. It did not require man made rituals for the sanctuary and tabernacle, but the attendance upon these was now spiritual and not carnal, or physical.

For the remaining precepts of chapter 8, the ideas can be interpreted by explaining the following scripture: "Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfill" (St. Matthew 5:17).

The law that was given to the children of Israel includes the following: The Ten Commandments, the ordinances of attendance upon the alter and the sanctuary, (which consisted of offering the blood of dead animals by the priest for the sins of the people), and the order of the Levitical priesthood as it pertained to the law of tithing - enforced for the stability of the nation and the economic good of the tribe of Levi. Each tribe in the nation of Israel was given an inheritance according to the promise made by God to their founding father Abraham.

The promise was that of a new land, one flowing with milk and honey, that the nation of Israel was to possess after they succeeded out of the wilderness from following Moses. All the tribes received a portion of the new land. Some receive portions of the land that was not across the river Jordan, nevertheless, they received the promise. But the tribe of Levi did not receive land as their inheritance, instead, they received the office of the high priest and were instructed to take tithes of the people in order to sustain them physically, and to intercede for the people's sins by attending to the alter.

Then there were many other added ordinances, such as, laws of property; laws of ethical and judicial behavior; laws and ordinances for rituals of diet, family, worship, and much more; and all these rules and regulations - in which the children of Abraham were to follow - were considered, the law. These laws were to be taught to and lived by every citizen of the nation without any help from a comforter, (which the believers of today have the privilege of possessing). For the record, any soul who does not possess the comforter (Holy Ghost), in this age of grace, are still bound to and will be judged by, the laws of the Old Testament.

God knew that man needed this extra help in keeping the law, the most difficult being the Ten Commandments. So, he sent forth the Spirit of his Son to live in man, or whoever received his Son, in order for the law to be lived and fulfilled in whoever received the Spirit. Thus, in verses 10-13 the Lord announces a new covenant, a New Testament, under a new and everlasting priesthood. One that there will be no need to obey carnal ordinances and rituals for the sacrificing of sins because he will totally wash away all sins and remember them no more using only one sacrifice; his only begotten Son, Jesus

Christ, who taketh away the sins of the world. Then in verse 13 he states: "A new covenant, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxen old is ready to vanish away."

God enforced this new covenant because he desired for his people to be perfect, and since the law made no one perfect because of the infirmities of the flesh, he sent forth his Son, in the likeness of sinful flesh, to overcome the sins and disobedience of the flesh. The children of Israel walked in the flesh; they worshipped God in the flesh, and they died in the flesh. They will also be judged by the law, based on whether or not they kept the law as directed by Moses and upheld by the high priest.

But, when God decided to have mercy on humanity, because he loved us so, he reformed the covenant in order to help our infirmities. This is when he sent forth his Son so that whoever believed in him might overcome the flesh, and death, and live eternally; and this is called the Grace of God. Therefore, he did not destroy the law but fulfilled it with one that would prevail over all written law: "Love worketh no ill to his neighbor: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law," (Romans 13:10). And this is all he requires from a believer when it pertains to salvation - love.

Chapter 9 verse 1 of Hebrews describes the first covenant as having a worldly sanctuary. This means that all the ordinances and rituals of worship services were fleshly and physical. Verse 2-7 details all of the physical characteristics of the tabernacle along with the priests' daily services in relation to the offerings for sins. Verses 8-10 probes deeper into the symbolic meaning of the services. These were not yet made manifest but were only a type of forethought as to what was to come. Revealing the fact that these carnal services were only practiced until the time of the reformation, or changing of the covenant, which would then make the believer perfect as pertaining to the conscience.

The consciences' of the children of Israel were least effected by all the ordinances and attempts to keep the law. The priest offered for their sins in fleshly means thus only justified their sins in the flesh, and not in heart or mind. This aspect of perfection must be remembered as we continue on, that, under the inspiration of grace, the spirit and interceding power of Christ is to perfect the mind, soul, spirit, and flesh, and not just the flesh only, as the ordinances or the law did.

The remaining of chapter 9 expounds on the ordinances of offering blood upon the altar for the remission of sins. The children of Israel offered the blood of dead animals as a sacrifice for the forgiveness of their sins. The high priest could not go in unto the tabernacle without the offering of the blood of an animal; this is the carnality of the law.

The believers today do not have to offer the blood of a dead animal for their sins every day because that is what Christ did when he offered himself for the sins of the whole world. Not only was he an offering for our sins but he died just as the high priest died and past on the priesthood to the next generation, yet Christ rose from the dead, (something they could not do), to give eternal life to anyone who believed he rose. Christ entered, not just into the physical tabernacle, or holiest of all made with hands, but he died and entered into the presence of God himself, in order to make intercession for the sins of those who believe.

Chapter 10 verses 1-3 state that, the yearly sacrifices - which were carnal - can never make a believer perfect (another thought to be remembered once we reach our point in discussion) "for then would they not ceased to be offered?" verse 2. We would still be offering sacrifices each day and year in order to

cleanse us of our sins, yet our consciences would never be clean, due to the carnality of the services; therefore, we, and God, would always remember our sins within the guilt of our consciences'. But God promised, and confirmed it by an oath, that he would not remember our sins no more.

Verse 5 is an essential part of this lesson; it provides a root to our theory once we prove that nothing is more important, or even honored by God, than the body itself (which includes the heart, soul, and mind).

All burnt offerings or any kind of sacrifices we give unto God, especially those of material value, cannot take the place of your willingness to be a living vessel for his use. Verses 6-14 establish this truth, and also verify the fact that the one offering of Jesus upon the cross replaced those sacrifices and offerings. He offered himself ONE TIME for the world. There is nothing else that can be given upon the altar as a sacrifice ordered under any commandment that was not covered by the offering of Jesus Christ; therefore, any ordinance carried over from the law has no effect or honor with God. For, all these carnal commandments were disannulled by grace.

Verses 19-25 exhorts all believers under grace to take advantage of this period of grace and be not entangled with the laws of ordinances. There is a new way in which we are forgiven and accepted by God. Not through carnal ordinances and offerings, or through the intercession of any high priest but one. He does not require the blood of goats and bulls, and since he is not from the tribe of Levi, neither does he require a portion of your tithes. We are no longer under those aspects of the law, even though Christ is made high priest after the order of Melchisedec. Abraham gave Melchisedec an offering only one time.

It was recorded only once that he gave him a tenth, therefore, if Jesus died once for us then we are required to offer unto Jesus one time, and that not of a tenth, but of all that we own; chiefly, our whole body, which is our reasonable service. The scripture exhorts us to hold fast to our faith in the everlasting covenant and not in the old; having our bodies, hearts and minds washed with pure water, the water that cleanses us from our sins forever, not just for the year.

Verses 26-39 of Hebrews chapter 10 is in relation to the start of our booklet, at the beginning of chapter 6 of Hebrews. It draws on chapter 6 by reminding the believer that, if a soul does not advance to the point of perfection (which calls for a certain knowledge of the principles of grace), then certain hindrances begin to occur in their growth. It emphasizes that there are no more sacrifices remaining for our sins if we fail to come to the obedience of the gospel as it relates to perfection.

If a believer counts the blood offering of the new covenant as an unholy thing, or as something offered in vain, then that soul will draw the vengeance of God upon them. In order to fulfill obedience under grace one must have faith in the covenant, and not in carnal offerings and ordinances. In order to be justified by faith through grace, one must disregard any suppositions that anything offered to God in the form of material substance has no meaning with God; it is the body only that God will honor.

"Now the just shall live by faith:" verse 38. We must have faith in the new covenant, not in divers washings and meat and drink offerings that were a part of the law. We must see Jesus as the high priest of the new covenant, not our pastors or earthly sanctuaries. We must not trust in earthly riches or manmade traditions and ordinances of worship, but the true worshippers will worship God in Spirit and in truth. The truth being, there are no more carnal offerings that God will except. The truth being that Jesus is the ONE TIME high priest and we only have to offer to him one time, and that being our bodies. The truth being, under the divine covenant of grace, offering to God is as simple as this: tithe once and give all.

Part two - Perfection in Grace

Once the book of Hebrews interprets the meaning of the law versus the law of grace in chapters 6-10, chapter 11 begins to explain faith, which is needed for spiritual justification in this age of divine grace. Faith in Jesus Christ will deliver a soul from under the bondage of the carnal ordinances of the law, and from the curse of sin and death, (which the law breeds), and take him into the revealed and divine laws of grace. In this second part we will continue our search for perfection in grace while dissecting the law of tithing, replacing it with the new law of giving - which is the unveiled method of prosperity under grace.

We have established the fact that as long as a soul is under the law he will never obtain perfection, therefore, perfection must come by grace. We have also established the gospel truth that tithing was an ordinance under the law by reason of the tithes being an inheritance for the tribe of Levi. We also came to the conclusion that, when Jesus was made the high priest after the order of Melchisedec, a change in priesthood meant also a change of the law.

In connection with these discovered, biblical truths, we will openly reveal the customs of many of today's churches that use tithing as a means of support, constituted by Old Testament rituals. Whether leaders justify tithing from under the law or from under the promise of Abraham, we will show that there is a new and better way to support the church financially. Also, we will enlighten those who use tithing as a means of support to the revelation that, as long as they continue in this ritual, they will fail to see complete perfection as offered by Christ.

Before Abraham gave Melchisedec a tenth of the spoils, God required from Abraham a complete trust in his words. In Genesis 12:1 it reads, "Now the Lord said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: And I will make of thee a great nation, and will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:" This commission from God was a great one.

It called for Abram to rely wholly upon the voice and promise of the Lord. He had to trust in his words and actually do what the Lord said to do. He had to leave his land, his family, and all that he knew and go into a strange land, one that he had never known before. The Lord promised him prosperity and security if he obeyed him and Abram did, and he received. This is faith in the grace of God.

Believing that the Lord will provide when one has no idea what lies ahead. He had no other instructions or promises to rely on but the voice of God. He did not have the law of tithing in order to base his prosperity upon, neither did he have any other ordinances or commandments that would assure his future standing with God, he only had the inspiration of the Almighty to lead him.

Chapter 11 of Hebrews is based upon this same principle. It describes the conditions under which the patriarchs, prophets, and women of God had to rely on, not just their money or their church traditions and sanctuary's services, but on the providing power and words of God; and they did not even inherit the promises of God. "And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise" (Hebrews 11:39).

Faith calls for a leaving behind of what we once new and moving on to something not even seen, but perceived through the divine inspiration, or grace of God. It calls for casting off perpetual traditions that lead to nowhere and sacrificing those things and people you count and rely on, and plummeting into the promises of God. Faith takes up where dependency leaves off. So, faith came long before the idea of tithing (which was only a symbolic forethought of the way the nation of Israel was to be run).

Melchisedec was a shadow or representation of the high priest to be brought forth for Israel, and Abraham was a forerunner of the nation of Israel, just as the law was a shadow and type of the grace to be revealed. Because the nation of Israel served God under the law of carnal commandments, tithes were collected not only for the supporting of the Levites, but for the sustaining of the nation as a whole. It was a physical law of nature.

But grace is a spiritual law, a law that requires faith, not an established system of physical maintenance. For example, to assure the payment of rent or house note, one relies on a job as the foremost means of support. But if a person has an imaginary house, one that is not seen what then, do they rely upon? Faith, to believe that the imaginary house is always there. This image of the house is the spiritual image, while, the actual house is the physical. It does not take faith to supply the physical needs; it takes the source of a material. In order to supply the spiritual needs, it takes the essence of inspiration. (But faith has been known to cross over into the physical world thus supplying a need, yet the spiritual can never be supplied by the natural).

The natural must always come before the spiritual in order for the spiritual to be fulfilled, as in the case of the law before grace, and the natural life of Christ before the spiritual, and even our natural lives before our spiritual. Yet, there is never a moment, in this world, where the spirit relies on the natural to sustain it.

Therefore, material goods or carnal ordinances cannot sustain a spiritual house of God. Neither can a spiritual law be sustained, or even comprehended by physical means. Tithing was a natural law; it was enforced to sustain the children of Israel and the tribe of Levi. It was a law that operated off the fruits of the ground, the spoils of material goods and increases. Tithing has no place in a spiritual law.

In order to gain anything of God through grace, you must have faith, and faith is the evidence of things not seen. You cannot sow a seed in the ground and when the grass has sprung forth you can say it came forth by faith, no; it came forth by the natural law of reaping; same principle of tithing. The Israelites tithed to the Levites, and God, the first fruits of the ground or of any goods they were supplied with from God, and this was to guarantee their future stability as a physical nation.

But when Jesus came, he brought with him a spiritual law, one that did not require sowing and reaping of the earth but of sowing and reaping of spiritual seeds. You cannot sow material seeds and expect spiritual blessings; you will only get natural blessings. You cannot give anything material in exchange for spiritual gifts; you can only give spirit offerings. Therefore, in order to acquire anything from God in the age of grace you must have faith and sow a spiritual seed, or a seed unseen, in order to receive from him anything from above.

Some people will say, "How is the church suppose to pay their light and gas bills if the congregation sows only spiritual seeds, the church needs actual money?" First of all, if the saints of God had a deeper

understanding of grace, they would know that unlimited power lies within the essence of grace. It is an extremely high level of spiritual power that is full of love and all other spiritual fruits, like generosity.

If a person loves the Lord to the full extend of grace they would surly give a generous amount of physical money in exchange for occupancy of a physical building. If the saints were entrenched in the power of grace they would gather more often than two or three nights a week to worship God, they would gather everyday like the saints of the early church, and they would experience this powerful amount of grace and love. If the saints knew the heights at which true grace climbs they would have enough love in their hearts to denounce many other forms of material gain which will enable them to give to the upkeep of the church.

Now, tithing pays the bills yes, but this is its downfall, notice:

"Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith, these ought ye to have done, and not leave the others undone" (St. Matthew 23:23).

Jesus condemns the leaders of Israel because tithing was the only thing they enforced. Just as many churches do today, they will tell the congregation that if they do not tithe, they are committing a sin. This concept lacks good judgment, not to mention mercy and faith. How can a person have faith when they are tithing for a material foundation? Under grace, faith is the substance of things hoped for, not known; the evidence of things not seen, not things seen, such as the light bill receipt.

Furthermore, Jesus was speaking to the Pharisees at a time that the law was still in effect (for he had not yet risen), therefore, he included tithing as a property of the law; he compared it to judgment, mercy, and faith as being weightier matters of the law. So tithing is an attribute of the law, not of grace. If a person continues to practice any aspect of the law they will never come to understand grace, or can they come to perfection.

A perfect example of grace is described in the book of Acts 2:41-47, and 4:32-37. The believers were not tithing, they were selling what they already owned and worked for and giving it unto the Apostles. They were denouncing material things in exchange for spiritual riches and fruits. They were GIVING! At the end of Acts chapter 4, verse 36, 37, there is a simple, yet powerful passage that emphasizes the fact that even a Levite; "having land, sold it, and brought the money, and laid it at the apostles' feet." verse 37.

This is a clear example and confirmation that the laws of tithing and receiving of tithes were overpowered by the essence of grace. Tithing is easy to trust in because it is a sure means of supplying the needs; but leave the comfort zone and enter into faith and one will know true grace and the true providing powers of God.

Another confirmation that faith is better than actual substance, is portrayed in the request of Jesus to his disciples, which reads, "And every one that hath forsaken houses, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, shall receive an hundredfold, and shall inherit everlasting life." (St. Matthew 19:29).

This commission from Jesus to all those who would follow him is similar, if not exactly what God instructed Abraham to do; to leave all and follow him into a new land and be blessed for ever more. This

action under the age of grace calls for faith unfeigned; it calls for an absolute trust in Jesus Christ and his gift of grace, and the promise of hundredfold blessings, not only in this life, but also in the life to follow. Now many would rather have this promise from the Lord Jesus Christ under grace, than that ONE blessing in Malachi to come from the windows of heaven after giving your tithes and offerings.

In short, it is better and more justifiable to serve God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ when it comes to the promises under grace of an everlasting life, than to die and fall short by crucifying Christ because of a dedication to the carnality of the law. So, in order to come unto perfection, a soul must be removed from the curse of the law; and in order to obtain the promise, a soul must first do the will of God; in order to do the will of God, one must first know that will.

"Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law." Romans 3:28

Women Preachers

The once controversial issue of women as preachers and church leaders is no longer a controversy, but an accepted part of church organization. Because of society's paranoia of sexism in mainstream lifestyle and the forced hand of government policy, women have taken on many more leadership positions in the church in every denomination, despite what the Bible says on the issue. This is a classic case of the church's transformation to the standards of the world. Those who have infiltrated the church with such beliefs have twisted the words of the Bible to fit society's standards and their own desires.

The Bible gives two direct rules concerning women and their ordained positions in the church and several implications to a woman's authority in the gospel, including various concepts that clearly explain a woman's duty to Christ, to the church, and to their family. However, each of the above areas are also defined by society concerning a woman's position, authority, and duty to Christ, to the church, and to their family, and we will compare the two using both the Word of God and its concepts, and the concepts, rules, and laws of society.

First, we must understand that this new movement of women's leadership in the church erupted from society and not from within the church. The church - which includes all believers of God - did not suddenly one day decide to protest the rights of women feeling that the men in the church were sexist, no, it was the women in the world, outside of the church, who brought this mentality to the church. For years, religion and church organization has continued as it was from the days of old concerning men's roles and women's roles. Only in the past 50 years, have these traditions change because of the gender battles that changed society, which gave women more power in the operation of society. Therefore, this mentality spilled into the church from society and did not stem from the church thus proving that the church has conformed to the world's ways.

When this mentality seeped into the church, church leaders sought out scriptures from the Bible that would supposedly support the women's upward positioning in the church. They not only used scripture, but they used concepts and theoretical reasoning to back their positions. To argue these theories, we will use scriptural and biblical reasoning that will uphold God's will: beginning with scripture.

The most popular scripture used by the women's movement and supporters to convince church-goers that God has no problem with women preachers comes from Galatians 3:28, which reads, "There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus." This scripture supposedly proves that it does not matter what race, status, or gender a person is if they believe in God that determines what a person can do for God. They argue that this scripture gives women the right to occupy any position in the church they want so long as they believe, and that it makes no difference to God. Along with this scripture they use Romans 2:11, which reads, "For there is no respect of persons with God."

Neither scripture directly says that women can take authoritative positions in the church, yet the scriptures are the only two in the Bible that the women's movement use as solid doctrine to support their claims. The scriptures are mere implications because neither scripture directly speak about the position of women, but

about anyone concerning anything. For instance, if the subject were race these scriptures would serve to integrate discriminated people into the gospel of Christ and into the kingdom of God. Furthermore, if the issue were on master-slave relationship the scripture would apply, as far as the slave being permitted the right to seek after the salvation of God and of His kingdom. God does not have respect of persons where it pertains to anyone being included into the gospel of Christ and His kingdom.

The scripture in Galatians 3:28 follows a concept of the Bible that discusses judgment against certain people, not about church position. The concept is a broad general statement that speaks on the rights of people to have access to the kingdom of God. If read from the beginning of Galatians chapter two, one would see that the discussion is about judgment and not church organization, therefore, no one can rightly and justly conclude that the scripture supports the women's rights to take authoritative positions in the church. As so, with the scripture explaining God's respect of person's in Romans, God does not discriminate against who can enter the kingdom and who cannot. If every scripture were read about God's ability to be fair towards people, none would refer to a woman's position in the church, but as a general statement period.

However, the Bible does directly address church organization where position is concerned and it speaks about women in particular, not in general. Unlike the above scriptures of Galatians and Romans that make broad statements, the following scriptures distinctly apply to women's positions and roles as doctrine, or biblical law. Furthermore, more often than not, church leaders will ignore the following scriptures and place more emphasis on Galatians and Romans. The first scripture reads, "Let your women keep silence in the churches; for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under obedience, as also saith the law. And if they will learn anything, let them ask their husbands at home: for it is a shame for women to speak in the church" (1 Corinthians 14:34, 35).

To silence the mouths of foolish and cynical people, understand first, that the scripture means exactly what it says and there is no other interpretation or hidden concept. Some will argue that Paul wrote the scripture and that it was only his opinion, however, the scripture also says, "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness" (2 Timothy 3:16). Any person who attributes any of the Bible's concepts to the credit of the author of that concept is attempting to escape what the Bible teaches. God gave all words of the Bible to the men by revelation of the Holy Ghost and the men recorded the words in a book. The scripture of Corinthians means what it says.

Women should keep silent in the church, as in not talking, questioning, or preaching. The scripture does not mean that women should help in keeping people from talking during the sermon - many would attempt this deception - because the scripture refers back to whom it is talking about when it says, "it is a shame for a woman to speak in the church." The scripture also exerts the fact that this rule of church worship comes from the law of the Old Testament, which is the only law carried over from the Old Testament. Preachers will carry over from the Old Testament the law of tithing but they will not adhered to the law of the submission of women, which again confirms that the church has conformed to the world.

When the scripture in Corinthians talks about women asking their husbands at home, it also means just that. Submission to the head of the marriage is a part of the gospel and this rule should remain in force. Society has equalized the marriage now so that the wife has as much authority as the husband, which they enforced with written law by way of the government: however, the Bible does not recognize man's law if

it interferes with what He says. The man is still the head of the relationship and if God says that the woman should ask questions at home and not raise her voice in church, then that is what the church should obey.

The next scripture that directly confronts the authority of women is in 1 Timothy chapter 2, which reads, "Let the women learn in silence with all subjection. But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence. For Adam was first formed, then Eve. And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in transgression" (vs. 11-14). The scripture distinctly says that women are not suppose to teach or usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence, which confirms the scripture in Corinthians. Teaching and being in authority over men means preaching to, leading, or pastoring men or a man. Though the Bible says that women should not take authority, it is the reason why God does not allow it that confuses people.

Why, people ask. Why should not a woman pastor churches and preach the gospel of Christ. Then they get theological and suppose God is not like what we think and that he is a liberal and hip God, and He understands. So, they ignore the Word and become presumptuous about what the scripture means. They have long forsaken the Word of God and any reasons why God would say that women should not preach. No church leader has explained to people why God disallows women to take authority over men and people take advantage of this lack of knowledge and impart their own rules.

As the scripture above states, "Adam was not deceived, but the woman was deceived being in transgression." The point of the scripture is to make plain that women are the weaker vessel and are more vulnerable to the attacks of the Devil and his scheme to destroy the church, believers, and humankind. When the woman ate of the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, she caused an unchangeable curse that lasted more than four thousand years, which was the curse of death, Had Satan tempted the man, the story may have ended differently, but that is not what the Bible wants us to know.

God wants us to acknowledge His plan and perfect will by accepting the absolute that God did not create woman equal to man but women are, in fact, created for man. "Neither was the man created for the woman; but the woman for the man" (1 Corinthians 11:9). This is how God planned life to be and this is how the world, especially church leaders, should live. Each species has their God-given role in life and we should respect that role and not attempt to change it for our own benefit or in subservience to the world. The essential reason why women are not suppose to take leadership roles over men is that it is against what God has created.

The next obvious reason is that women are equipped for life differently than men. God gave women the natural ability to nurture the child, He did not give that ability to men and men should not take it upon themselves to assume the role of a nurturer if they are not equipped with what is natural. On the other hand, because women are not equipped with what men have naturally, which is the responsibility of leadership over the earth, society, his wife, and children, women should not attempt to take on that responsibility but should concentrate on what God ordained.

The above reasons are not Biblical but naturally obvious. If biblical sense is to be made for why women should not lead men, or flocks, then believers must believe and obey the two doctrinal requirements for women, which are to keep silence and not usurp authority over the man. However, the Bible does justify the weaknesses of women compared to men in 1 Timothy 3:7, which reads, "Likewise ye husbands, dwell

with them according to knowledge, giving honor unto the wife as the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered." The Bible says that in a marriage, the woman is the weaker vessel and that the husband need relate to her with that as a consideration. The concept of the scripture is clear, God created men stronger than He did women: physically, emotionally, and spiritually.

Yet, the above still does not convince those who are adamant in their beliefs that women have rights to leadership positions in the church. Once they ignore the doctrine in the scriptures, they move on to various examples in the Bible that supposedly show that women can preach the Word. For instance, in the parable of the woman at the well in St. John chapter four, they justify that Jesus ordained the woman as an evangelist because she carried the Word into the city and preached to the religious leaders. It reads "The woman then left her water pot, and went her way into the city, and saith to the men, Come see a man, which told me all things that ever I did: is this not the Christ?" (St. John 4:30).

From this act, people say that the woman went and preached to the city about Jesus, and many preachers teach this to people and the people take this as true. They then go a little further to prove that the people believed the woman, therefore, she brought forth the Word and that means she is a preacher. They quote, "And many of the Samaritans of that city believed on him for the saying of the woman, which testified, He told me all that ever I did" (vv. 39). However, the preachers never point out the part in the above scripture that says the woman "testified" not preached, and they never go any further to see what the scripture says after that, and what the people said about her message.

In verses 40, and 41, the scripture says "And many more believed because of his [Jesus] own word; And said unto the woman, Now we believe, not because of thy saying: for we have heard him for ourselves, and know that this is indeed the Christ, the Saviour of the world." In other words, even after the woman came and testified about Jesus, the people (and the Bible) says that they believed in Christ but not because of what she said or because of what today's liberal church-goers would have unlearned folks to believe, that the woman preached and people believed, but the people believed because they heard Jesus for themselves. Therefore, the woman was not a preacher.

People today attempt to use many other concepts of the Bible to prove that woman can preach and lead flocks of God but the Bible is always in defense of itself. God does not contradict His own Word and neither has He not done a new thing - another concept of the scriptures they use - and called women to preach and lead His flocks. The truth is that women have roles and those roles are to nurture and raise children to be loving and faithful believers of Christ and of God: to be virtuous women and wives and to be in submission to their own husbands and to the male leadership of the church.

Because the churches today are under the influence of the world, and have a hard time obeying the doctrine of God, the church is falling to the seduction and deception of the Devil. The natural order of life and of the church is in total opposition to what God desires and it is getting worst. First, the office of an evangelist was at one time the only office women dared to assume because of the "woman at the well" concept, but when they saw that men fell for the intrusion, they went a step further. Women became deaconess, the female version of the deacon, and then they became ministers, recognized by secular institutions of religious learning. Then when there was no opposition to that, church organizations began ordaining women as assistant pastors, and co-pastors, and now they are Bishops and Apostles, the highest offices in the church and no one is opposing the moves.

In all of the above, no church has yet to biblically justify the ordainment of women as either leadership authorities. The façade has snowballed into an illusion of what the world has implanted in the church. Despite what the Bible says about the qualifications of a deacon, elder, or bishop, which refers to each as men and husbands, the church world today will enforce what they believe to be acceptable to God. This abomination and disrespect of God's Word will ultimately consume the church to the point that nothing in the Bible will have authenticity, but religion will be what man believes it should be.

A woman who follows the concepts of the Word of God will live blessed of God and would better understand her calling. Women may prophesy, testify, and attend to their biblical duty which is to, "teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, to be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands" (Titus 2:4, 5). How We Came To Be: - The Story of America's Black Nation

Without safeguarding the reputation and dignity of the so-called African-American in the United States, and without belittling the rationale and God-given character of the Anglo-American, this study will approach the equality issue in America in the utmost empirical view. Using sound, biblical reasoning and historic evidence, the following study will explore past, present, and future relations between the two ethnic groups to evaluate any progress, regress, or stability as a result of both coexisting in this land in regards to the possibility of equalization.

The biblical perspective is based on human nature and the preordained purpose of God, and the historical perspective is based on man's natural lust and conquest for world supremacy and dominance. By the end of the study, a clearer picture of the relations between two world powers will develop as to whether equalization is possible amid the incoherence and politically correct jargon of today's theoretical framework of the social structure. Henceforth, the term "Whites" will substitute for Anglo-American, and the term "Blacks" will replace African-American.

INTRODUCTION

There seems to be some disillusion in many ways and among many people about the progress or regress of the relations between blacks and whites where it pertains to equality. Some say relations have improved and equality is not a far-fetched possibility, a theory based on sociological studies and statistics of historical data, and acceptance of this theory has eased tension among those who believe it. Still others

believe that there remains a problem in terms of inequality even to the extent of the outward show of "blatant bigotry" and others to the effect of day-to-day situations of "timid bigotry", yet, the dilemma cannot go unattended if only for the sake of the country's future. To actually determine where the problem of inequality in America lies - if there is one - one would primarily have to understand the mindset of selected individuals.

For instance, if you ask a young black male who lives in the ghetto of Harlem if blacks and whites are equal, he would probably say no, they are not. Yet, if you ask a young white girl who attends a mildly integrated college and gets along fairly well with her black classmates, she would probably say yes, race relations are improving. There are various answers and beliefs among many people to take into consideration when evaluating racial equality or inequality in America.

For the purpose of this study, we will view the dilemma from a macro/biblical-level that will allow us to angle the cultural lens at time and chance thus focusing on the preordained and expected mentalities of each ethnic group, both blacks and whites. In other words, the study will place society at present on the biblical prophecy of whose turn it is to rule the world.

In addition, the study will consider the institutionalized levels of the past and present America, and finally, zeroing in on individual ethnicity, world view, and opinion, will expose the mindset of the main players in the game of human equality. The depths of the study will rest on the foundation of honesty and fact without regard to preference or time. The resolution to any problem will never be reached without first acknowledging its beginning.

THE BLACK MAN AS MASTER

Before America, before the rule of Rome, before the white man, before the Birth of Christ, there was the legacy of Egypt. (Contrary to popular modern beliefs, Egyptians were Black people, not white people, as scholars today would have people believe). A nation built from the root of African granite and stone, Egypt stood as king and ruler among the world. A rich history of kings and queens that carried themselves in the stature of dignity and pride executed the authority and discipline it takes to manipulate a society.

Monopolizing the world's resources for the good of the entire world and maintaining a relationship with nature that gave them the strength and intuition to survive any crises of that day and age, the North African people walked in an arrogance that even God honored. However, in that arrogance they suppressed a nation of people of a different creed and subjected them to the unpleasant task of human bondage. For four hundred years, the nation of Israel was slaves to the taskmasters of the black man of Egypt.

When the time of deliverance came from on high, by God's own might, the Pharaoh's of Egypt stood firm against God's commandment to free the people of Israel from the Egyptians grip of slavery. Soon after the wonders of God, Pharaoh released Israel to him but as a product of 400 hundred years of suppression, the Israelites built the greatest empire known to humankind.

It was preordained that the Israeli nation served the Egyptians as slaves for the simple pleasure of God who wanted to demonstrate his power over humankind. He personally hardened the heart of the Pharaoh just so he could show different signs and wonders to the world before the Egyptians freed Israel.

Afterward, he convinced Egypt and Israel that he was God, and every other nation of the world realized his power.

Throughout the history of the Old Testament, God raised nations in power and plunged them into ruin for years at a time. Babylon, Ethiopia, Israel, Rome, Greece, and now America, are all partakers one way or another in the pleasure of God to ultimately show his powers. Nations have conquered other nations, monopolized the world's resources, fought endless wars for control of a land, and bound one another to slavery and or servitude. From a biblical perspective, slavery as a stride to world domination has always played a part in history, although, men neglect to see the overall purpose and plan of world ruler-ship and practiced the art of superiority and supremacy over the exploited, and in many cases skin color was a factor, but in most others, it was religion.

Another reason God allowed submission of one nation to another was for the disobedience that nation displayed because of a given commandment by God. Because of Egypt's pride and treatment of the Israeli nation, God imposed punishment upon them, even though it was by his consent that they oppress Israel. Acknowledgement of him is vital to the stability and future of any nation. Given the chance, a nation was suppose to recognize God's presence and adhered to his demands. But one might ask, how can you adhered to someone that demands you disobey him, as in the situation with the Pharaohs of Egypt when God purposely hardened the Pharaohs heart.

Again, the purposes of God are always two and three-fold. God no more used Egypt as an oppressor to fulfill an earlier plan, one that was a lesson to the sons of Israel, than he did order Joseph into the land of Egypt to be enslaved. Hardening Pharaohs heart was only a subdivision in the stratagem for Israel to occupy their own land and to know whom their Lord was. Confusing, as it may seem, the preordained destination of a nation lies within the scheme of a supreme being who does all that is done for his own pleasure.

Subjugating a nation of people to the brutalities of another for more than four hundred years is but a mere component in the realm of logic that unfolds into the desired results of the originator. Likewise, equality has never been an absolute law of humanity; therefore, world dominance and ruler-ship has shifted from one nation to another over the course of history in respects to the differences of culture and geographical ethnicity, and, according to whose turn it is to rule the world. Egypt had their turn. Now it is the white man's turn, and the black man's turn to suffer in consequence of a 3000-year old punishment. Yet, who knows what lies ahead for the destiny of either nation, black or white?

THE WHITE MAN AS SUPREME

After the birth and death of Christ, many nations adapted Christianity as a world religion. Nations from every corner of the earth attended the day of Pentecost and heard men speak in the tongues of different languages. Whether a person, or scientist, acknowledge this turning point in humankind as one to market the gospel of Christ throughout the world and among the various nations, is one of personal preference, nevertheless, the Birth of Christ marked history as the beginning of the end.

Without controversy, recorded documentation of how the world received Christianity, as a religion was one that leveled the playing field for all. No one man or nation begat Christianity, nor can any one take full credit nor assume reproach for its beginning; therefore, Christianity is not deemed a man's religion,

but again, a cog in the logic of God. Also, as a reflection of his relationship with the Israeli people, Christianity, and Christ, serves as a catalyst to the fulfillment of a world originated and operated by its creator. Beyond all reasoning of man, the destiny of every nation relies on acknowledgement of the existence of God.

Supposedly founded on this belief, America is in the beginning to mid stages of disobedience to God. They also, will suffer punishment just as all other nations did who rose above the acknowledgement of God. Moreover, the institution of slavery served according to nature, as a devise used to build and to assess the character and faith of a nation, which is presently the white man.

The greatest myth circulating through the minds of many people, both black and white, is that slavery was ordained as a benefit to the black man because it introduced him to Christianity. However, it is evident that the black man, during the time of correlated rule of Egyptian and Ethiopian nations along side the Roman and Israeli nations, already knew of Christ; therefore, there is no way Christianity was new to the black man nor slavery as a benefit for him. Slavery is for the benefit of the oppressor, never the oppressed.

If there is, any benefit gained from the act of slavery for the oppressed and further justified as a religious one, it would have to be viewed from a biblical perspective and not a human one. Men are obviously ignorant to the biblical perspective if they have resorted to enslaving a nation, unless, they see the destiny of the enslaved in the form of deliverance and reward, and their own destiny as eternal punishment.

For, if the Pharaoh had known that Israel would, soon after freedom, establish their own system of government, and that his nation would self-destruct, he would have never enslaved Israel. Thus, the white man of America even in reasonable intelligence can never justify the enslavement of the black man as being a benefit to them without acknowledging that they, themselves, will soon fall to destruction.

Along with the supremacy theory comes arrogance, and arrogance is definitely a factor in the mentality of the white man. Arrogance is a highly deceiving mentality that blinds even the most highly intellectual mind aware of its deception. Unconsciously and unintentionally, white men have utilized the supremacy theory to his own ignorance. In other words, he is so overcome with, and wise in his arrogance, that he will never admit to there being a racial or inequality problem in this country and especially that he is the cause. Consideration is vital in understanding what goes on in the mind of a white person.

Putting ones self in the white man's position can enlighten anyone to why they think the way they do. If a person were born into the role of supremacy, in a country where the majority rules, and taught or even influenced by the situations that stereotype ethnic diversity to the extreme, they would automatically accept their role, unconsciously, as superior. If circumstances were reversed, and blacks were in power, they would have the exact same mentality; this is only natural. So the white man can never actually be blamed for their mindset, for it is a given in the course of humanity.

Expecting nothing less than arrogance from the white man is customary and is to be tolerated and understood by the black man, or any other minority group within his country. Yet, tolerance of "blatant bigotry" and unnecessary violence imposed on the enslaved or oppressed is extremely difficult to accept as natural, although, this too, is explainable as a characteristic under the influence and result of arrogance.

In addition to the white man never admitting that he is the sole reason for racial inequality and turmoil in this country, and many parts of the world, and that it is because of his arrogance that the problem will never be resolved, he, also unconsciously-intentionally, fights to maintain his superiority, substantiating the theory of group threat. Yet, in his mind, he is being as fair as possible to all people of the world where it pertains to survival and dispersion of the earth's resources.

Equality is a concern of his where it pertains to all men of the world so long as all men are equal among themselves, wittingly acknowledging him as supreme. He cannot help that he is in world authority; to him, it is the curse, and undoubtedly an act of nature that he is supreme. To the distress of many though, his acceptance as the world's gift to mankind exposes the arrogance by which he operates, and sometimes it is only by the distress of others that the good of humankind will be satisfied [in his mind].

When establishing the foundations of America, the white man was only doing what was best for those in whose land he extorted and those in whom he enslaved. He, the white man, was at the time all that counted in the world. All others were sources of negotiation, goods, or capital. Negotiations and trade among other nations, including African nations, were mere investments in the world's future. In other words, it was always business, never personal, until, white men began to realize that blacks, Asians, and Indians, had minds and could actually learn by being be taught. Before that, as stated before, they were only capital and property.

Once the white man reasoned that other ethnic cultures other than his own could contribute to the building of his nation did he begin to see them as actual humans. The assimilation of the three different cultures, African, European, and Indian, after so long a time of cohabiting with each other, enlightened the white man to the fact that he was, in so many words, possibly expendable. Therefore, he regressed to the defense of group threat, where members of the dominant group perceive that the minority group threatens their well-being. As a result, he adapted the mentality of protecting what was his to assure the future and betterment of the world. No one could ever assume the role in which nature had thus ordained him (the white man) to stand.

This is when the white man began to concoct a plan to deter the advancements of other nations. To do this he had to covet and own most of the world's resources to assure complete control of the world. Many nations would not bend to the conquest of the white man thus he resorted to schemes of compromise in the form of deception. He had to think and stay one step ahead of other nations or at least control something of value and need of that nation. So, when it was time to consider what the world needed to survive, he reasoned that oil, land, and many other amenities necessary for survival had to be under his control, thus, he approached the people whom occupied and lived on those resources and either forced them off, deceived them, or compromised a fraudulent deal with that country.

If actual resources could not do the trick then he resorted to what he knew best would restrain any opponents in case his treasures were threatened, which was violence. Moreover, to this day, it is by violence that he retains the world. Beyond that, he has no knowledge of how to maintain his power and authority over the world, for, in the event deception, force, or compromise fails, war is declared on whatever nation refuses his offer. Much like the mafia.

ETHNIC ASSIMILATION IN AMERICA

The above situation of Egypt and the nation of Israel are similar, if not identical to the crises of the American black man and his taskmaster the white man. The only difference in the two is that, the Israelis left the land of Egypt to dwell in the land that God promised the Father's of Israel, yet after blacks were freed from the bondage of slavery, they remained to this day within the land of the whites.

This is central and vital to understanding the underlying concept of ethnic equalization between blacks and whites because the possibilities of group threat increases. This was one of the reasons the Egyptians decided to enslave Israel because Israel's population had increased even to outnumber the Egyptians. Although whites willingly brought blacks to America against their will, after a number of years the black population increased, yet not perceived as a threat.

At one time, the rumor circulated that there was a conspiracy to annihilate the black population in America using drugs as a self-destructive force among blacks. Again, many today believe that the prison system is another form of population control of the black male, yet these are mere presumptions. Nevertheless, now that blacks are free and the population continues to increase, whites may feel threatened in other areas such as economically and politically.

Rarely have one nation had to live among the oppressor as have blacks among whites. Normally, in history, the slave nation was sent afar off into a place prepared and especially made for them, or they were slaughtered by the dominant race in an attempt to annihilate them all together. In several ways, the latter act of annihilation, or at least possible destruction of the black slaves of America, was eventually considered as opposed to shipping them back to their native land. Yet was there ever an attempt essentially to send the black nation back to Africa, or did the black nation decide to stay after being giving an option.

The answer to this question is another central point to this study because compared to a case of a battered wife by an abusive husband, out of phobia and over-assertiveness, both fall into a state of either severed love or intense hate. In other words, blacks and whites have established a love-hate relationship, which may mean an improvement between the two that carries with it a mutual respect for each other's social role. Nonetheless, there is an attachment between the two cultures and exist a bond that, even though formed by the act of slavery, has come to endurance, acceptance, and tolerance on both ends, black and white, yet what constitutes equality?

There are various forms of equality such as personal respect, social status, and simple humanity. Of course, after hundreds of years of slavery, the descendants of any nation who are born and die in the state of slavery come to accept it, even long after protruding through the questions of why. At the same time, the descendants of the oppressor grow to accept their role as master, and possibly even to a gracious manner. Thus, even in the process of an unbroken cycle such as slavery, social roles, regardless of what nature, eventually lead to some form of equality, which in this manner is in terms of mutual respect for that role.

For instance, during the rule of Egypt over the Israeli people, Joseph, the son of Jacob, an Israelite, rose to a status higher than that of many Egyptians, demonstrating personal acceptance and stratification among two different cultures. Therefore, it is possible for two individuals performing opposing social roles, one

of slave status and one of superior, to respect one another for that role. Nevertheless, the assimilation of two nations and the question of equality requires more than personal acceptance.

Blacks themselves began to adapt the white man's mentality as he grew in America. In comparison to a child that grows under the influence of his or her parents, blacks actually had no choice but to accept one or more of these mentalities, be it oppression, arrogance, or violence (for instance, street gangs emulate the gangsters of the roaring twenties and can never be accused of possessing a violent temperament by nature). Supremacy, though, is a characteristic of the white man that can never be adapted by the black man, simply because blacks were not born into that state of mind.

Although, arrogance due to superiority can easily be adapted, and even now is. The superiority mindset among blacks has repeatedly proven to be detrimental to the well being of a black person and especially those around him. The reason is, blacks do not fully understand what it means to be superior, at least not in the present cohort, they only imitate what they see whites do which erects a wall more of pretense than authenticity. In other words, whites are better at superiority and arrogance than blacks because they were placed in this position naturally and blacks only assume it. A black person lacks the confidence that upholds arrogance and replaces it with pretentious assertiveness that no one adheres to but other blacks. Whites will never seriously accept the authority of a black person but only endure it as an act of accommodation or standardization at the most, but never superiority.

For this cause, blacks that assume superiority status are as outcast to the white man and by other blacks that contend the supremacy theory all together. A subculture of blacks is anomies within a nation of cultural assimilation and especially inequality. In an attempt to gain recognition among whites through what whites said would gain them that recognition - which was an education and hard work - blacks blindly and vainly followed the advice only to realize that it gained nothing more than high social status within a world of their own, with that in question.

Striving to better themselves and fit into the cultural norms and mores' of white America, blacks received some acknowledgement of their achievements on a personal level by way of individual compliments by white friends presumably under the constraints of courtesy, yet on a social-institutional level that acknowledgement has but scratched the surface of equality in the face of supremacy.

BLACK INEQUALITY

As long as ethnic-assimilation is stressed with equality as an objective, there will never be unity among blacks, because the struggle is not one for the black man, but for the black man to be white. The pursuit of this goal is in total ignorance and indignity of ones own ethnic identity, but pursued through envy of an attribute of sheer self-indulgence.

Essentially, the initial question is whether the two races should be integrated, or segregated, not whether they will ever be, or rightfully be equal: that is biblically impossible, at least in this life. Although blacks socially, occupationally, and institutionally integrate with whites, there remains, within those times, segregation which gives rise to inequality.

In the cafeterias of culturally diverse institutions of learning, and in the high-rise office buildings of every downtown, in more instances than none, the whites will sit with the whites and the blacks sit with the blacks. The blacks that have fallen into the norm of racial anomie, or the elite, black middle class who believes in being socially equal to the white man, are forevermore separated from the black masses, which challenge the theory of social equality and request by nature, human equality. Therefore, the black population is divided on the surface.

Middle class blacks believe as the white man believes. He agrees that with hard work and stick-to-itness, any one, no matter what color can achieve the American dream. He is also convinced that racial inequality is not as serious a problem as perceived by the masses of blacks, simply because if he made it to such status - no matter how irrelevant that status is to the white man - that any one can make it. He believes that there are not as many barriers that halt the black race where it pertains to succeeding in this nation especially when he is seated beside the white senior corporate officer of one of the nations fortune 500 companies, making suggestions already being considered by the executive. He is convinced that the opportunities offered by the American government to the underprivileged is more than sufficient for a person who wants to succeed, and furthermore, that poverty is now only a condition of those who accept it, not of those confined to it.

This mentality is spreading rapidly throughout the nation, that poverty is a result of ones own choice. No one has to live in poverty if one does not want to because there are many opportunities for equalization among the elite. Whites truly believe that the days of black ghettos are over and the only reason the residues of blacks remain in poverty is by choice. This is no more than a quick cop out to clear the conscious of the white man.

In addition, he has convinced the black middle class - who never ceases to emulate his mindset - of the same. In other words, slavery is over, Jim Crow is dead, equal opportunity is there if you want it, so do not blame the white man any longer for your troubles, or feelings of inadequacy. They have literally, and with a sad attempt, tried to clear themselves of the troubles of blacks and their own shame of racism. They are freeing their conscious' of the guilt that will never actually cease to be a part of their mind simply because slavery and discrimination is a deep-rooted, immoral sin against humanity, and one never forgotten of God.

The fact remains that there is an ethnic-inequality problem in America. Whites own and control all the means of production in America, at least the ones that matter, and blacks own none of it. Would that be because blacks are incapable of organizing and operating a productive industrious facility? No, it is because they lack unity. The division among the black race, driven there by the white man in the early days of slavery, can be repaired at the discretion of the black race itself. Yet, it never will be if the only power structure of the black race is fashioned after the white mentality, that of oppression and arrogance.

To control any means of production is not yet a realization of blacks, at least not by the ones who have the most influence, because they remain caught up in the power and status structure of individualism. They continue to seek equal rights and fight for ways to further assimilate with the white man without regard to what is central for the growth of the black race, which is unity. No other ethnic culture in the United States or in the world is more divided than the American black man is.

The middle class blacks seek recognition and acceptance into the white race continually by agreeing with his theories, adjusting to, and following after his lead. The suburb is the gathering point of the black middle class: a means to attain and compete with the whites. They want equal schools and equal political

representation in the communities, yet status is the hidden factor, which can only be gained in the suburbs, and not where it pertains to their own communities.

Status and recognition is important to the black middle class. Without it, they have no identity. Lost and confused by the strategies of the white man, middle class blacks are going nowhere fast in the plight for social and economic equality. Without knowledge of controlling and maintaining industrialized institutions of economic productivity, not to mention of themselves, blacks are no more than what they were in the early part of the twentieth century, service workers.

They succeed in occupations of individual services such as physicians and lawyers and consultants, in addition to small capital ventures like small presses and government funded educational institutions, but they have yet to embark on larger entities. Clothing manufacturers, steel corporations, mining, oil, and lumber ventures are what the white race controls and no black man has dared learn or attempted to establish a corporation of this stature. If there are some who have tried and failed, and their reasoning is because whites have cornered the market and placed large monopolies on those type industries, then how can any black man in his right, logical state of mind say there is not an immense inequality problem in this country.

There is not a race problem, no, not according to the blacks that have succeeded in menial service occupations, because there is opportunity, and the average black has no excuse not to succeed. However, where is that same mentality where it pertains to industry? At, and in the corporate boardrooms and office cafeterias, no, there is no such thing as inequality, not as long as a black man is giving used advice to some fat-cat bureaucrat. Yet, in the world of reality where domination plays a key role in the survival of the fittest, the black middle class service worker is no more than a peon in the wheels of society.

Blind to the facts before his face, this black middle classman has lost all instilled within him through the plight of his ancestors. Assimilation among the white man is a joke to be told another millennial away. The struggles of the black man in America will be a fight remembered for its defeat due to the mind of the very ones who are partakers of that fight.

The black middle classman, who would rather fend for himself under the windows of opportunity, and equalize these United States to his power-seeking advantage, than unite with his own to establish an identity based nation. Who would rather believe that there is not a race problem, or that there is a race problem but only when it affects what it is he wants to accomplish. Never mind the souls of the ghetto in which his white counter part has poisoned his mind against to believe they are, in fact, lazy, shiftless, hustlers who live off the government that only tries to help him.

How can cultural assimilation and equality be good for America? If the white man ever realizes that, the resources of the world are here for everyone and not for him to control. Greed drives him to divide, conquer, and manipulate, and by any means necessary, he will protect what is his and continuously believe that he is ruler of the world. Nevertheless, the time must come when he must subside to the next supreme ruler, and who knows if then it will be his turn to slave.

America is in a state of decline simply because the lies and hypocrisy of the white man has surfaced even to the obvious. The less obvious, such as the black middle classman, will never see what the bible has

projected for the world because he is fascinated with the power structure of the white man. Therefore, when the white man falls, so will he.

Separation for the sake of maintaining assimilation, and acknowledgment of the fact that as a nation blacks will never be as the white man's equal, is a temporal solution for America. It would be better if the white man agreed to get along with his black counterparts instead of continually attempting to neutralize him, and others, for the sake of greed and selfishness. The black man will survive longer if he realizes that without unity or at least equalization between his own, there is no nation.

Individualism destroys any form of unity and that is why the black race is divided at the present. The supremacy theory practiced by white men have been taken too literally by the black middle classman, because regardless of how many poor whites there are and how many of them are rich, there is a common goal among them all. They have an identity that is fueled by supremacy and arrogance that, again, the black man lacks. He feeds off the mentality of the white man and turns to express this blatant and illiterate form of bigotry on his own people.

Nevertheless, when God decides it is time to finish off humanity, because of their constant disbelief and bickering among each other over who gets what and when, then the world will understand why there was never any one world ruler, but only one God to acknowledge.

Another Jesus

The Bible mentions another Jesus - besides the one born as the Savior - that will be worshipped by a people misguided in the overall concept of the gospel of Christ, the message of religion, and the purpose of salvation. The passage is in the New Testament book of 2 Corinthians 11:4, and reads, "For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him."

The above picture is supposedly Christ the Savior, created by a people misguided in the basic concept of the gospel of Christ and in the facts of religious history. This depiction of Jesus as a white man carries with it an ideology that assumes the character of whites, which sends a different message to the world than the message sent by the true Savior himself.

- And he said, What hast thou done? the voice of thy brother's blood crieth unto me from the ground.
- And now art thou cursed from the earth, which hath opened her mouth to receive thy brother's blood from thy hand;
- When thou tillest the ground, it shall not henceforth yield unto thee her strength; a fugitive and a vagabond shalt thou be in the earth.
- And Cain said unto the LORD, My punishment is greater than I can bear.

- Behold, thou hast driven me out this day from the face of the earth; and from thy face shall I be hid; and I shall be a fugitive and a vagabond in the earth; and it shall come to pass, that every one that findeth me shall slay me.
- And the LORD said unto him, Therefore whosoever slayeth Cain, vengeance shall be taken on him sevenfold. And the LORD set a mark upon Cain, lest any finding him should kill him.
- And Cain went out from the presence of the LORD, and dwelt in the land of Nod, on the east of Eden.
- And Cain knew his wife; and she conceived, and bare Enoch: and he builded a city, and called the name of the city, after the name of his son, Enoch.

Now, people want to know where Cain's wife came from if there were only Adam, Eve, Cain and Abel on the entire earth, this is the first assumption people make, which is a wrong assumption because of the concept of time.

Many Church Organizations are Similar to Cults

Are you or a Family Member a Victim?

The following statements, compiled by Dr. Michael Langone, editor of Csj.org - Cultic Studies Journal, often characterize manipulative groups. Comparing these statements to the group with which you or a family member is involved may help you determine if this involvement is cause for concern.

1. The group is focused on a living leader to whom members seem to display excessively zealous, unquestioning commitment.

2. The group is preoccupied with bringing in new members.

3. The group is preoccupied with making money.

4. Questioning, doubt, and dissent are discouraged or even punished.

5. Mind-numbing techniques (such as meditation, chanting, denunciation sessions, debilitating work routines) are used to suppress doubts about the group and its leader.

6. The leadership dictates sometimes in great detail how members should think, act, and feel (for example: members must get permission from leaders to date, change jobs, get married; leaders may prescribe what types of clothes to wear, where to live, how to discipline children, and so forth).

7. The group is elitist, claiming a special, exalted status for itself, its leader(s), and members (for example: the leader is considered the Messiah or an avatar; the group and/or the leader has a special mission to save humanity).

8. The group has a polarized us-versus-them mentality, which causes conflict with the wider society.

9. The group's leader is not accountable to any authorities (as are, for example, military commanders and ministers, priests, monks, and rabbis of mainstream denominations).

10. The group teaches or implies that its supposedly exalted ends justify means that members would have considered unethical before joining the group (for example: collecting money for bogus charities).

11. The leadership induces guilt feelings or fear in members in order to control them.

Members' subservience to the group causes them to cut ties with family and friends, and to give up personal goals and activities that were of interest before joining the group.

12. Members are expected to devote inordinate amounts of time to the group.

13. Members are encouraged or required to live and/or socialize only with other group members.

Many of the above characteristics can apply to hundreds of seemingly normal churches and religious organizations throughout the country. Religious organizations are considered the most likely to be of cult status.

If your pastor shows either of the above signs, which is not a biblical principle, then they may be headed in the direction of cult status. For instance, there are hundreds even thousands of churches today preoccupied with making money or being prosperous, which leads to mind and action control.

Church leaders influence members in all the above areas, however, they use the words of the bible to do so. It is very important to read the bible and understand the overall concept of salvation. Knowing the difference between God's plan and a cult's method of influence is detrimental to your future.

The book of Revelation chapters 2-3, 17 speak of the seven churches in Asia and seven kings; "five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space (Rev. 17:10)." The five that are fallen are doctrines and theories that did not stand during their time eras or have run their course in history, the one that is, is the present age (the mega-church), and the one that is to come is the religion of the Anti-Christ, and when it comes it will remain a short time.

To integrate the behavior of today's church with what will come about in the next reign, let us look at a reference to the following description of the church that is today and how they are bringing the religious world (members of the mega-church movement worldwide) into preparedness of the Anti-Christ rule.

Revelation, chapter 3 states:

14. And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;

15. I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.

16. So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

17. Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

18. I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

19. As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.

The lukewarmness of the church of Laodicea sickened God and was thrown-up (spewn) out of His mouth. It had no stability, no solidarity; no understanding of God's will and was thus cast out of The Body. In this current time age of prosperity and increase of personal wealth, the church has assumed the goal of gaining riches using the business tactics of capitalism to do so. Buying, selling, and trading in business, commercial products, and property to increase wealth among church leaders and members believing that wealth raises them to levels of power, respect, and control. This is a mirror image of how the New World Order will rise.

God tells them that in their thrust for wealth and great riches, they are in fact "wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked," as opposed to what they believe to be complete in all areas and "in need of nothing." Though they possess the wealth of the land, they are empty in spirit and walk through life in the motions without compassion.

If religious leaders can birth a multitude of people who believe that reward comes in material form as a result of menial sacrificial deeds, they can succeed in creating a people who lack compassion and are ripe for a system based on nothing more than buying, selling, and trading. If they believe that God rewards based on this type system, they will worship that God and unbeknownst any man who promises them such a world.

These people are blind to their ways, are filled with inner misery despite their riches, are spiritually poor (whereby they lack righteousness, true love, faith or any other fruits of the spirit), and they are naked before the world; their deeds are apparent to everyone but themselves. The church has no influence on the outside world at all, but is in fact influenced by the world and its evil practices, which have infiltrated the church itself.

Because of their wretchedness, God is giving them a chance to repent for their ways. He ironically councils them to buy from Him, gold that has been tried by fire. In other words, if they believe they are rich and have need of nothing, God requires them to take their riches and purchase (buy of [from] me) gold (experience, trials and tribulations that have past the test of true suffering) that they may truly be rich in spirit and not monetary wealth alone.

Unfortunately, today's church does not interpret the above scripture to mean what is described above because they are blind to the true ways of God and are unconsciously compelled to do the work of bringing the New World Order and the kingdom of the Anti-Christ to pass. A one world currency is in the making and churches encourage members to stay current with new financial trends. This push for members to work hard, buy land, and own capital provides a sure financial base for church leaders and makes servants and followers of a cult-like system of control.

3. For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.

4. And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

5. For her sins have reached unto heaven, and God hath remembered her iniquities.

6. Reward her even as she rewarded you, and double unto her double according to her works: in the cup which she hath filled fill to her double.

7. How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously, so much torment and sorrow give her: for she saith in her heart, I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow.

8. Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong is the Lord God who judgeth her.

9. And the kings of the earth, who have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her, shall bewail her, and lament for her, when they shall see the smoke of her burning,

10. Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for in one hour is thy judgment come.

11. And the merchants of the earth shall weep and mourn over her; for no man buyeth their merchandise any more:

--Revelation 18: 2-11

Prophesy of Europe: The King of the North

This read is going to touch on reality and spirituality unlike your pastor or any Western history book ever has. The title will unfold within the article and is the truth. The white man was sent from God to deal with the original man.

Many so-called wise minds, including scholars of Euro-decent, believe that Blacks are cursed of God; at least those with a religious inkling of thought. Many believe that white (Europeans) are God's gift to the world, to bring others to civilization and development, which is partly true.

Europeans are from God to the world but not as a gift, but as punishers of the original man (men): the Black African, the Hebrew (Olive man), and the Red man, or Biblically known as Ham, Sham, and Japheth of mankind.

Regardless of how many times or how far back the white historian tries to write himself into history, ancient anthropology, scribes, and artifacts never fail to reveal the absence of the Europeans during the dawn of man or even hundreds of thousands of years afterward. So whether one believes in the biblical account of humankind or the theory of Darwinism, new found recovered history cannot lie.

However, for the sake of the majority of the beliefs of humanity, this work will address this issue from a biblical perspective. The separation of mankind from one another by geographical boundaries and languages proves that the Creator had a divine plan and that plan continues unto this day.

Drawing from the Old Testament book of Daniel (prophet of the end time), we will unfold a mystery of the white man that he has yet to discover about himself or that he has chosen to ignore. An Afromerica Spiritual Interpretation (ASI) will follow every other verse for clarity.

The Prophesy

Daniel, Chapter 11

"1": Also I in the first year of Darius the Mede, even I, stood to confirm and to strengthen him.

ASI - Daniel speaks of Darius the Mede who was a ruler of the old Babylon the Great kingdom, which is today located in the areas of the Middle East, Baghdad, through to the Persian Gulf, in and around the cradle of civilization. He speaks to him concerning the future of the nations.

"2": And now will I shew thee the truth. Behold, there shall stand up yet three kings in Persia; and the fourth shall be far richer than they all: and by his strength through his riches he shall stir up all against the realm of Grecia.

ASI - Persia is modern day Iran (the Olive Man), and the Middle Eastern kingdoms (countries today) including Iraq and Iran. [Please use your own imagination to realize whose these names and places are referring to]. Grecia is modern day Europe, or Ancient Greek (Hellenic origin). In the above passage, the "rich" kings of Persia will rise against the kingdom of Grecia.

"3": And a mighty king shall stand up, that shall rule with great dominion, and do according to his will.

ASI - The king referred to symbolizes a royal family that rules and controls the resources of the Middle East throughout time. No one man or family in particular.

"4": And when he shall stand up, his kingdom shall be broken, and shall be divided toward the four winds of heaven; and not to his posterity, nor according to his dominion which he ruled: for his kingdom shall be plucked up, even for others beside those.

ASI - Over time, the kingdom (riches) and resources are broken down and split up around the world and partitioned to other areas of the earth. Resources as in Oil, and other valuables.

"5": And the king of the south shall be strong, and one of his princes; and he shall be strong above him, and have dominion; his dominion shall be a great dominion.

ASI - The king of the south is the spirit of the Middle East and Northern Africa that remains strong above the rest of the world, even of the sons born into royalty. The resources and rule in that region of the world are unchangeable and will stand forever.

"6": And in the end of years they shall join themselves together; for the king's daughter of the south shall come to the king of the north to make an agreement: but she shall not retain the power of the arm; neither shall he stand, nor his arm: but she shall be given up, and they that brought her, and he that begat her, and he that strengthened her in these times.

ASI - The king's daughter refers to the weaknesses of the kingdom that makes agreement with other nations, mainly those of the north, or Europe. But she cannot maintain the agreement nor can either of the current rulers or kings of that time.

"7": But out of a branch of her roots shall one stand up in his estate, which shall come with an army, and shall enter into the fortress of the king of the north, and shall deal against them, and shall prevail:

"8": And shall also carry captives into Egypt their gods, with their princes, and with their precious vessels of silver and of gold; and he shall continue more years than the king of the north.

"9": So the king of the south shall come into his kingdom, and shall return into his own land.

ASI - During this time is the rise of the kingdom of Palestine and of the Arab world over that of Africa and Israel that pushed his armies through Jerusalem and later toward the north in Greece, and also pushes downward through northern Africa, Syria and Egypt, conquering nations and kingdoms thus establishing Arab rule.

"10": But his sons shall be stirred up, and shall assemble a multitude of great forces: and one shall certainly come, and overflow, and pass through: then shall he return, and be stirred up, even to his fortress.

"11": And the king of the south shall be moved with choler, and shall come forth and fight with him, even with the king of the north: and he shall set forth a great multitude; but the multitude shall be given into his hand.

"12": And when he hath taken away the multitude, his heart shall be lifted up; and he shall cast down many ten thousands: but he shall not be strengthened by it.

ASI - The above were the wars of Egypt, Babylon, Troy and Greece to struggle for the lands and to war for power, and Greece rises but does not prevail yet.

"13": For the king of the north shall return, and shall set forth a multitude greater than the former, and shall certainly come after certain years with a great army and with much riches.

ASI - After many years, Greece rises again and Alexander the Great (of Euro-decent) returns to conquer the lands of Africa and the Middle East and then pushes toward the east, China and the Isles, setting up taxing governments and kingdoms over the people.

"14": And in those times there shall many stand up against the king of the south: also the robbers of thy people shall exalt themselves to establish the vision; but they shall fall.

"15": So the king of the north shall come, and cast up a mount, and take the most fenced cities: and the arms of the south shall not withstand, neither his chosen people, neither shall there be any strength to withstand.

ASI - Division is rampant in the south (northern Africa down throughout the Sahara) and trade becomes a matter of survival. The old kingdoms fall to intrusion of foreign armies and Rome set up governments in Israel and North Africa, which led into the birth of Christ. Referring to Israel as the chosen, the mid east falls to Roman rule.

"16": But he that cometh against him shall do according to his own will, and none shall stand before him: and he shall stand in the glorious land, which by his hand shall be consumed.

"17": He shall also set his face to enter with the strength of his whole kingdom, and upright ones with him; thus shall he do: and he shall give him the daughter of women, corrupting her: but she shall not stand on his side, neither be for him.

ASI - Europe began to search out Africa and conquer kingdoms and peoples and land and this is when they took over Egypt as their own; they raped the women and mixed with Arabs and Jews and Africans, and began to colonize that area of the world as their own and make agreement with the rulers for trade and commerce.

"18": After this shall he turn his face unto the isles, and shall take many: but a prince for his own behalf shall cause the reproach offered by him to cease; without his own reproach he shall cause it to turn upon him.

"19": Then he shall turn his face toward the fort of his own land: but he shall stumble and fall, and not be found.

ASI - During this time, Europe began to divide as each sector partitioned the resources and lands of the world for their own gain and they establish stronger governments amongst themselves, Rome, Britain, Germany, France, Spain, Dutch.

"20": Then shall stand up in his estate a raiser of taxes in the glory of the kingdom: but within few days he shall be destroyed, neither in anger, nor in battle.

"21": And in his estate shall stand up a vile person, to whom they shall not give the honour of the kingdom: but he shall come in peaceably, and obtain the kingdom by flatteries.

"22": And with the arms of a flood shall they be overflown from before him, and shall be broken; yea, also the prince of the covenant.

"23": And after the league made with him he shall work deceitfully: for he shall come up, and shall become strong with a small people.

"24": He shall enter peaceably even upon the fattest places of the province; and he shall do that which his fathers have not done, nor his fathers' fathers; he shall scatter among them the prey, and spoil, and riches: yea, and he shall forecast his devices against the strong holds, even for a time.

"25": And he shall stir up his power and his courage against the king of the south with a great army; and the king of the south shall be stirred up to battle with a very great and mighty army; but he shall not stand: for they shall forecast devices against him.

"26": Yea, they that feed of the portion of his meat shall destroy him, and his army shall overflow: and many shall fall down slain.

ASI - Israel will come into agreement with Europe and will attempt to regain control of the region but will not succeed because of the advancements of Europe. In exchange for power, Israel will conquer and make war with surrounding lands (northern Africa and Middle Eastern nations such as Palestine), but not without resistance.

"27": And both these kings' hearts shall be to do mischief, and they shall speak lies at one table; but it shall not prosper: for yet the end shall be at the time appointed.

ASI - Europe and Israel will conspire to control the region and will succeed but not honestly. They will grow and prosper in the world but the time of vengeance for the other nations (Africa and Middle East) is not yet come.

"28": Then shall he return into his land with great riches; and his heart shall be against the holy covenant; and he shall do exploits, and return to his own land.

"29": At the time appointed he shall return, and come toward the south; but it shall not be as the former, or as the latter.

"30": For the ships of Chittim shall come against him: therefore he shall be grieved, and return, and have indignation against the holy covenant: so shall he do; he shall even return, and have intelligence with them that forsake the holy covenant.

"31": And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily sacrifice, and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate.

ASI - The European nations will grow and prosper from the riches of the world and from the land of Israel, and even as Israel is defiant to God and will worship Idols so shall the European neglect the truth about God, the gods of the Middle Eastern and African lands, even the God of the Fathers. Verse 31 is the calling of the Beast, the anti-Christ and all that is against the holy covenant of Israel and the gods and the Fathers of the Holy Land. They will begin to worship the All Mighty dollar.

"32": And such as do wickedly against the covenant shall he corrupt by flatteries: but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits.

"33": And they that understand among the people shall instruct many: yet they shall fall by the sword, and by flame, by captivity, and by spoil, many days.

"34": Now when they shall fall, they shall be holpen with a little help: but many shall cleave to them with flatteries.

"35": And some of them of understanding shall fall, to try them, and to purge, and to make them white, even to the time of the end: because it is yet for a time appointed.

ASI - Those who do wickedly are those who follow after the idolatry of riches and the riches of the lands they have stolen from. They believe no longer in the daily sacrifice or the covenant of God but in the power of their forces. But there are those who know the truth and hold to the truth and to the power of God, who are not deceived, and they will be tried and persecuted and enslaved and oppressed many days. They have little faith and are over-burdened and they hold on but many still fall into the corruption of money and riches and power of the world.

"36": And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done.

"37": Neither shall he regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god: for he shall magnify himself above all.

"38": But in his estate shall he honour the God of forces: and a god whom his fathers knew not shall he honour with gold, and silver, and with precious stones, and pleasant things.

"39": Thus shall he do in the most strong holds with a strange god, whom he shall acknowledge and increase with glory: and he shall cause them to rule over many, and shall divide the land for gain.

ASI - Europe is now in complete control of the world's resources and is oppressing the people of the world by withholding and partitioning the goods. He has no regard for the gods of anyone but his own, which is not God but is of corruption. But the time is not yet.

He oppresses women, and has no regard for life or dignity. He honors military power (the God of forces), and even does away with the god of his fathers. He worships money and power and pleasures of life and he convinces many to believe and worship the same. He continues as he conquers and divides Africa among his people for the glory of power and riches. This is the Scramble for Africa.

"40": And at the time of the end shall the king of the south push at him: and the king of the north shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, and with horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries, and shall overflow and pass over.

ASI - Africa tries to rise and fight him but he comes at him with his armies and forces and destroys the king of the south and the nations within it. He rapes the countries and peoples and transports them using ships, and he enters the land on feet to destroy.

"41": He shall enter also into the glorious land, and many countries shall be overthrown: but these shall escape out of his hand, even Edom, and Moab, and the chief of the children of Ammon.

ASI - Edom, Ammon, and Moab are all Jordanian nations in close relation to Israel but of Africa decent, which serves as a buffer between Palestine and Jerusalem.

"42": He shall stretch forth his hand also upon the countries: and the land of Egypt shall not escape.

"43": But he shall have power over the treasures of gold and of silver, and over all the precious things of Egypt: and the Libyans and the Ethiopians shall be at his steps.

ASI - Europe takes control of northern Africa and eventually all of Africa from top to bottom in his conquest for world power. They have deceived and by force taken the world and to this day remain atop. However...

"44": But tidings out of the east and out of the north shall trouble him: therefore he shall go forth with great fury to destroy, and utterly to make away many.

ASI - There is a threat to Europe and the white man, which is the East, China and the Asian nations, the Red man. Also, his own brother, the Russian Caucasian will rise against him because he has dealt deceitfully with him in his conquest for power. So he is angry and increases persecution against the weak.

"45": And he shall plant the tabernacles of his palace between the seas in the glorious holy mountain; yet he shall come to his end, and none shall help him.

ASI - In the end, Europe will sit high on the world in power and glory with his throne in the virtual place of the Holy Land while protecting the interest of Israel. Thus he sits, but his time is near. And when it comes, there will be no one on earth to help him or ease his pain.

Fret not my Black brothers and sisters and other colorful people of the world. We will rise from oppression and be exalted once again to our natural place on earth. For he shall destroy himself with his own devices and the world will become a place for the original man to once again roam free...Amen.

Mega-Churches Will Fall To The Beast

The irony is that the Bible foretells of a time when the world will advance into a system that will require all people who want to survive and or live a normal life, to receive a mark in their right hand or forehead that will allow them - and them only - to buy and or sell goods and services. The scripture reads:

15: And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

16: And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads:

17: And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name (Revelation 13).

Spiritually speaking, Revelation has a three-fold meaning, as in past, present, and future. The passage above speaks of a coming age. The present age will soon end and life, as we know it today will be vastly different. This time may not arrive permanently for two or 3 generations, maybe more, but it will come.

The reason so many doom prophets today speak of the Mark of the Beast is because the situations in society are leading up to fulfill the prophesies of the Bible that were foretold thousands of years ago. The book of Daniel and the book of Revelation are most profound and accurate when speaking of these last days.

They will suppose that the anti-Christ is the Christ because it falls right in line with the teaching of their current pastor.

If, however, a believe is wise enough to realize that the Mark of the Beast is just that and they refuse to take it, they will have to sacrifice all they have and begin to live in poverty and fear of death. It is this

These men can say they walk with Presidents. Presidents who fly over. Presidents who belong to the plot to control, mold, and withhold from the people. Presidents who walk with other men who care not for the

Uncle Toms, White Preachers, and the Black Church Experience

Instead, they depend on government incentives that are barely enough to sustain one classroom let alone an entire community. This is where they must extend the hand of faith and love instead of charging market prices for their so-called private church schools.

In economics, church leaders and members have the know-how and skills to open and operate small to medium businesses that cater to the Black community such as health care for elderly and low-income, affordable child care instead of market rates, grocery stores that sell fresh foods instead of expired foods so many of our inner-city stores carry.

They can teach networking and business development skills, implement aesthetic programs for the children, and build transitional housing and work programs for recent release prisoners. Over time, drug use and crime would subside in the Black communities and progress will take hold. However, church leaders have not these visions for the people or the community but visions for themselves and their church buildings.

Concerning the moral character of the community, they must provide counseling classes and after-work sessions for working people instead of depending on the social services, child support, and court systems of the government. Instead of raw bible classes, they must address social concerns using biblical and proverbial concepts that people can relate to, this is a form of ministering without using hell-fire and brimstone tactics.

They must offer marriage and child rearing seminars in lieu of divorce courts and child support systems; financial, legal, and business prep courses instead of begging for government funds for social programs.
